DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 30.07.2025

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 30.07.2025 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 30.07.2025.

LAND:

Yesterday's low-pressure area over northwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood became less marked at 1200 UTC of yesterday, the 29th July, 2025.

BAY OF BENGAL:

An upper air cyclonic circulation lay over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha coast between 1.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, the 30th July, 2025.

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over north Bay of Bengal. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection lay over central Bay of Bengal.
