TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 26.07.2021 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 26.07.2021.

BAY OF BENGAL:

A LOW PRESSURE AREA IS LIKELY TO FORM OVER NORTH BAY OF BENGAL & NEIGHBOURHOOD AROUND 28TH JULY,2021.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER ARAKAN, GULF OF MARTABAN, NORTH BAY OF BENGAL AND ADJOINING CENTRAL BAY OF BENGAL. SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER NORTH ANDAMAN SEA.
