DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 29.08.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 29.08.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 29.08.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Under the influence of upper air cyclonic circulation over Northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining West Bengal-Bangladesh coasts, a low pressure area formed over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining West Bengal-north Odisha coasts at 0000 UTC and it persisted over the same region at 0300 UTC of today 29th August, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level. It is likely to become more marked and move west-northwestwards across north Odisha-Gangetic west Bengal during next 48 hours.

The Low-Pressure Area over northeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood became less marked at 0000 UTC of today, the 29th August 2026. However, the associated cyclonic circulation persisted over the same region and extended upto 3.1 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, 29th August 2026.

Scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection over the Bay of Bengal, the Andaman Sea, the Arakan Coast, the Gulf of Martaban and the Tenasserim Coast.

ARABIAN SEA:

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection over the south Arabian Sea, south of Latitude 10.0°N, the Maldives and the Comorin area. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection over the northeast Arabian Sea, the Gulf of Kutch, the Gulf of Cambay, the east-central Arabian Sea and the Lakshadweep Islands.

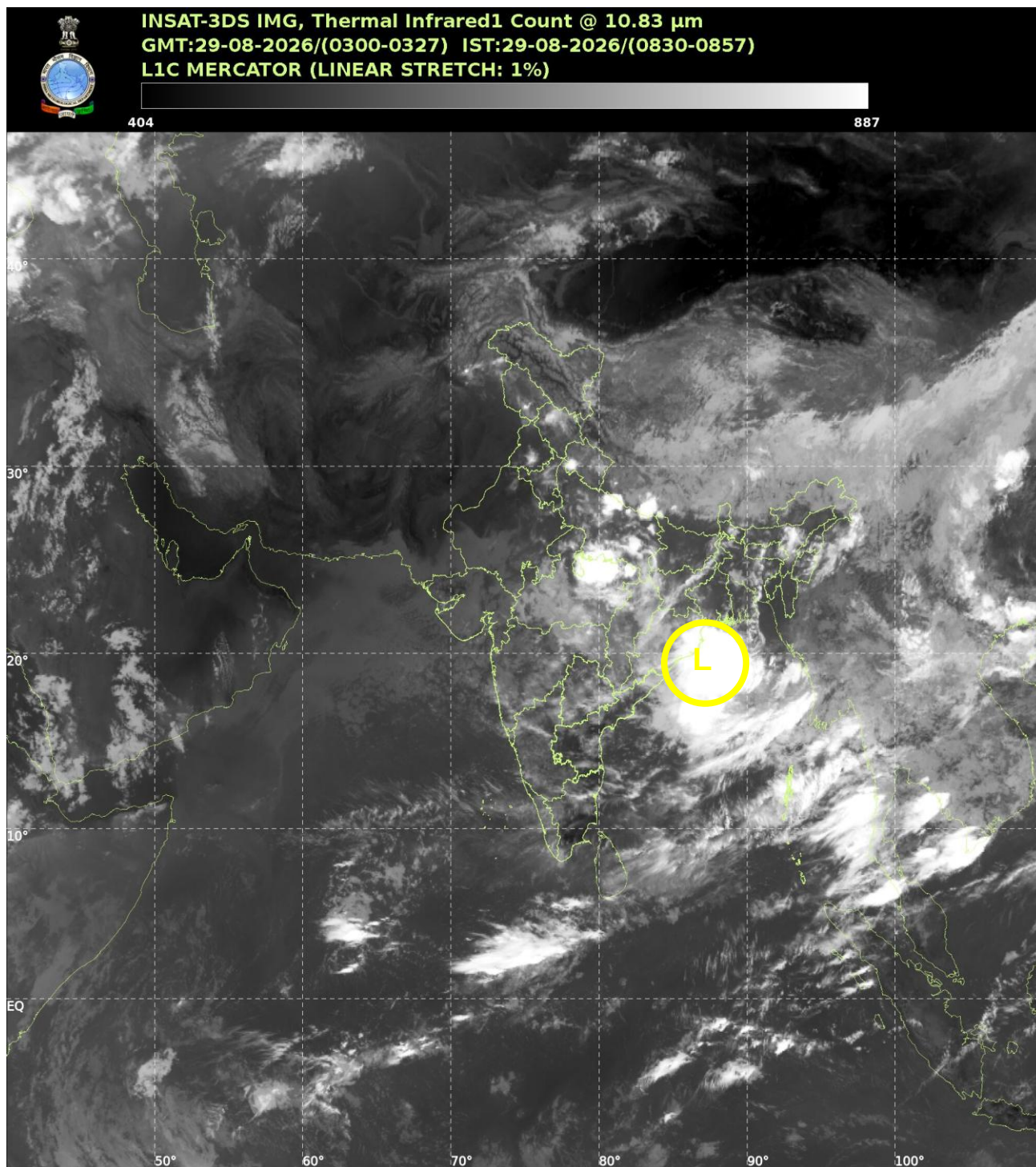
