DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 26.03.2025

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 26.03.2025 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 26.03.2025.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection lay over south Bay of Bengal south of latitude 10.0 °N & south Andaman Sea.

ARABIAN SEA:

A fresh cyclonic circulation lay over Gulf of Mannar & neighbourhood at 1.5 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, the 26th March, 2025.

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over south Arabian Sea, Maldives & Comorin area. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded weak convection lay over eastcentral & southeast Arabian Sea off south Maharashtra – Goa- Karnataka- Kerala coasts and Lakshadweep Island area.
