**BAY OF BENGAL:**

Scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the Andaman Sea and moderate to intense convection lay over the Bay of Bengal.

**ARABIAN SEA:**

A fresh upper air cyclonic circulation formed over Gulf of Mannar & neighbourhood at 1.5 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, the 06th May 2026.

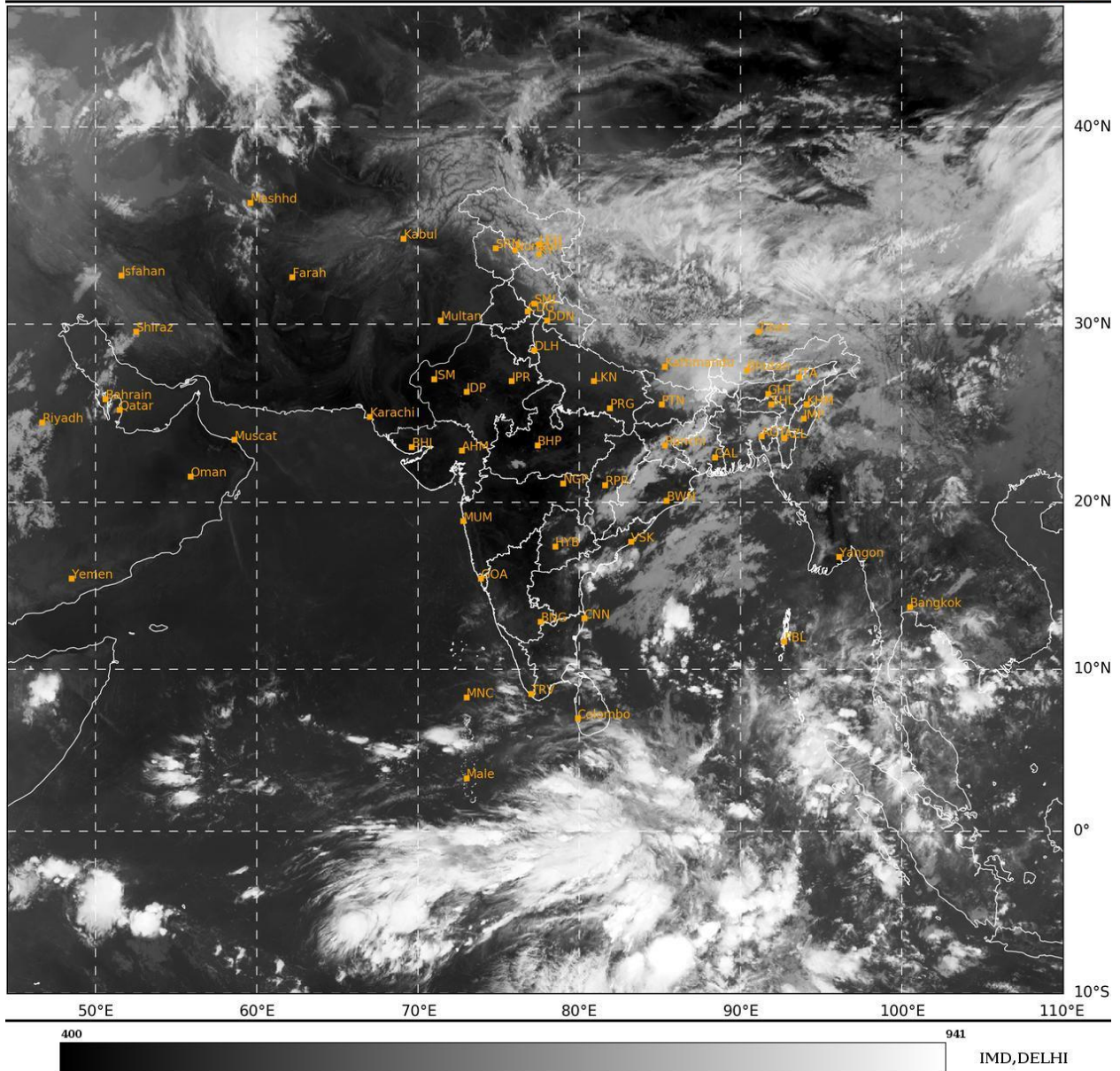
Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the south Arabian Sea, Maldives and Comorin area. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection lay over the eastcentral Arabian Sea off Karnataka coast and the Lakshadweep Islands area.
