TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 31.07.2025 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 31.07.2025.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's upper air cyclonic circulation over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Gangetic West Bengal and Odisha coast now lay over northern parts of Gangetic West Bengal and extended upto 7.6 km above mean sea level at 0300 UTC of today, the 31st July, 2025.

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over north Bay of Bengal and north Andaman Sea. Isolated moderate to intense convection lay over central Bay of Bengal and south Andaman Sea. Isolated weak to moderate convection lay over south Bay of Bengal.
