DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 23.07.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 23.07.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 23.07.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

A fresh upper air cyclonic circulation formed over northwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining north Odisha coast between 5.8 & 7.6 km above mean sea at 1200 UTC of yesterday, the 22nd July 2026. It became less marked over the same region at 0300 UTC of today, the 23rd July 2026.

Scattered to broken, low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the north Bay of Bengal, southwest Bay of Bengal off north Tamil Nadu coast, eastcentral Bay of Bengal, Arakan coast, the north Andaman Sea, Gulf of Martaban and Tenasserim coast. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the rest Bay of Bengal and the south Andaman Sea.

ARABIAN SEA:

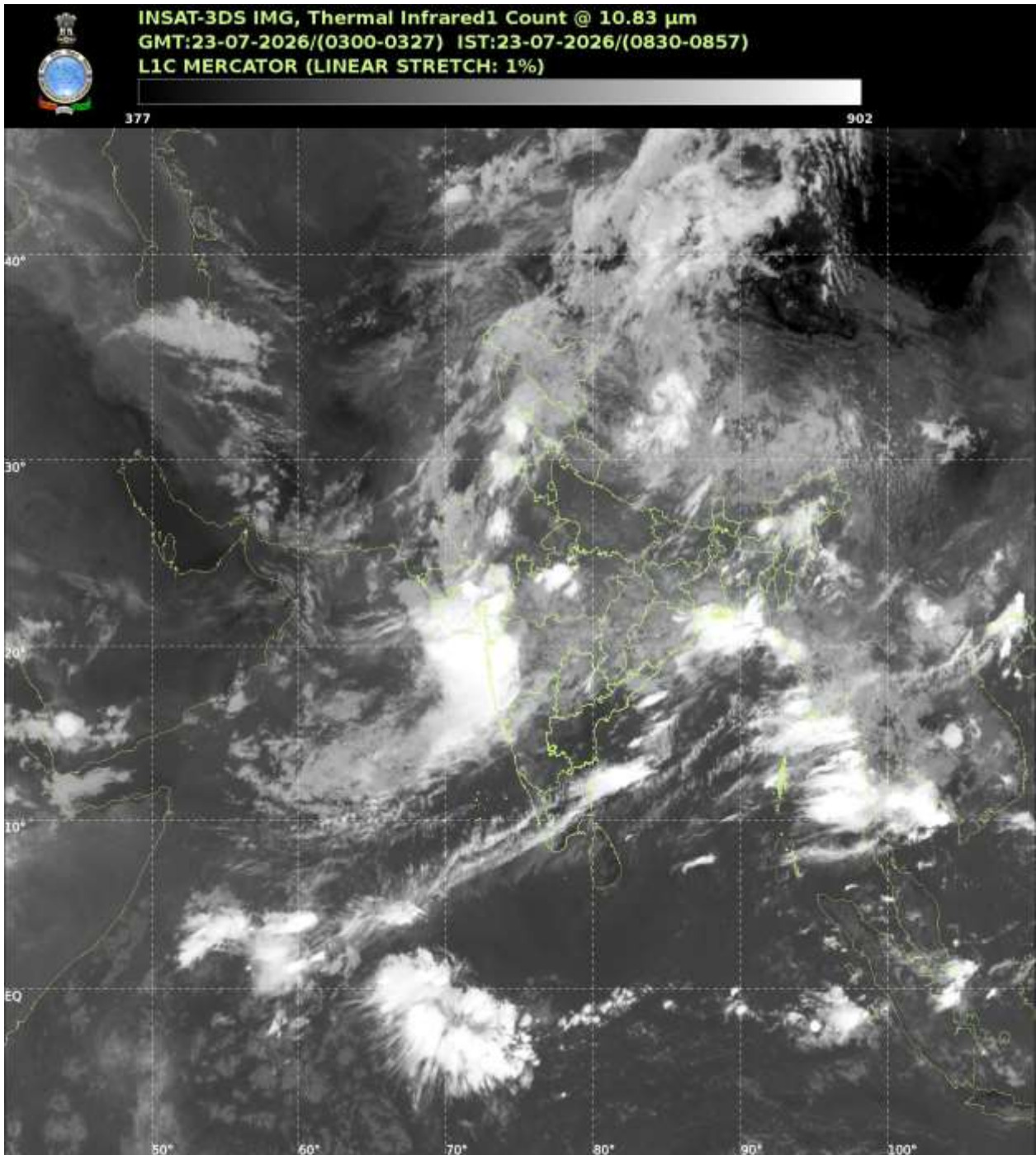
Scattered to broken, low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the northeast, eastcentral Arabian Sea off Gujarat – Maharashtra coasts & the Gulf of Kutch and the Gulf of Cambay. Scattered, low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the rest Arabian Sea and the Lakshadweep Islands area.
