DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 19.07.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 19.07.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 19.07.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Scattered to broken, low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the westcentral Bay of Bengal. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection are lay over the rest of the Bay of Bengal and isolated weak to moderate convection are lay over the Andaman Sea.

ARABIAN SEA:

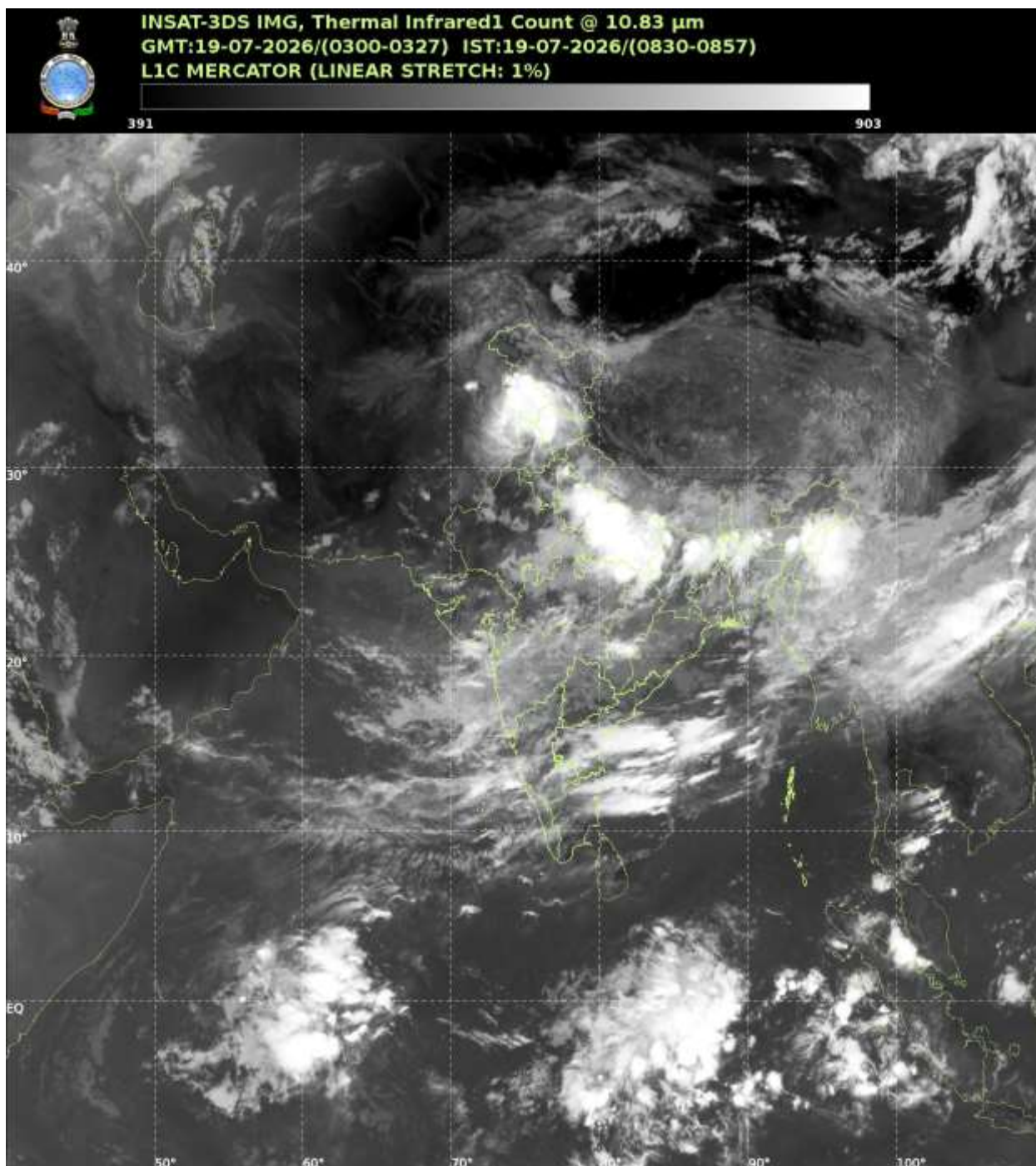
Scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over Gulf of Cambay, the eastcentral & southeast Arabian Sea and the Lakshadweep Islands area. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection lay over the rest of the Arabian Sea, Maldives and the Comorin area.
