#### **ARABIAN SEA:**

The Well-marked low pressure area over northwest Arabian Sea and adjoining southwest Pakistan persisted over the same region at 0300UTC of today, 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2025. It is very likely to continue to move nearly westwards and weaken into low pressure area over the same region during next 12 hours.

Scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded weak to moderate convection lay over Northwest Arabian Sea adjoining Pakistan coast, eastcentral Arabian Sea and Maldives area. Scattered low and medium clouds lay over rest of Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep Island area.


