DEMS-RSMC SPECIAL TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 27.02.2022

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR NEXT 120 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 27.02.2022 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 27.02.2022.

BAY OF BENGAL:

A CYCLONIC CIRCULATION LAY OVER STRAIT OF MALACCA & ADJOINING SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA WITH VERTICAL EXTENSION UPTO 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL AT 0300 UTC OF TODAY, THE 27TH FEBRUARY, 2022. IT IS LIKELY TO MOVE WEST-NORTHWESTWARDS AND CONCENTRATE INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA OVER SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL DURING NEXT 48 HOURS. IT IS LIKELY TO MOVE FURTHER TOWARDS SRI LANKA COAST DURING SUBSEQUENT 48 HOURS.

SCATTERED TO BROKEN LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL SOUTH OF LATITUDE 10.0° N, SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA AND STRAIT OF MALACCA (MINIMUM CLOUD TOP TEMPERATURE MINUS 75° C).
