DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 09.07.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 09.07.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 09.07.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's Well-Marked Low Pressure area over Northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Southwest Uttar Pradesh lay over southwest Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood at 0300 UTC of today, the 9th July 2026 The associated cyclonic circulation now extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level. It is very likely to move slowly northeastwards and weaken gradually during next 24 hours.

Scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over north and adjoining central Bay of Bengal, Arakan Coast, and Gulf of Martaban. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over remaining parts of Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

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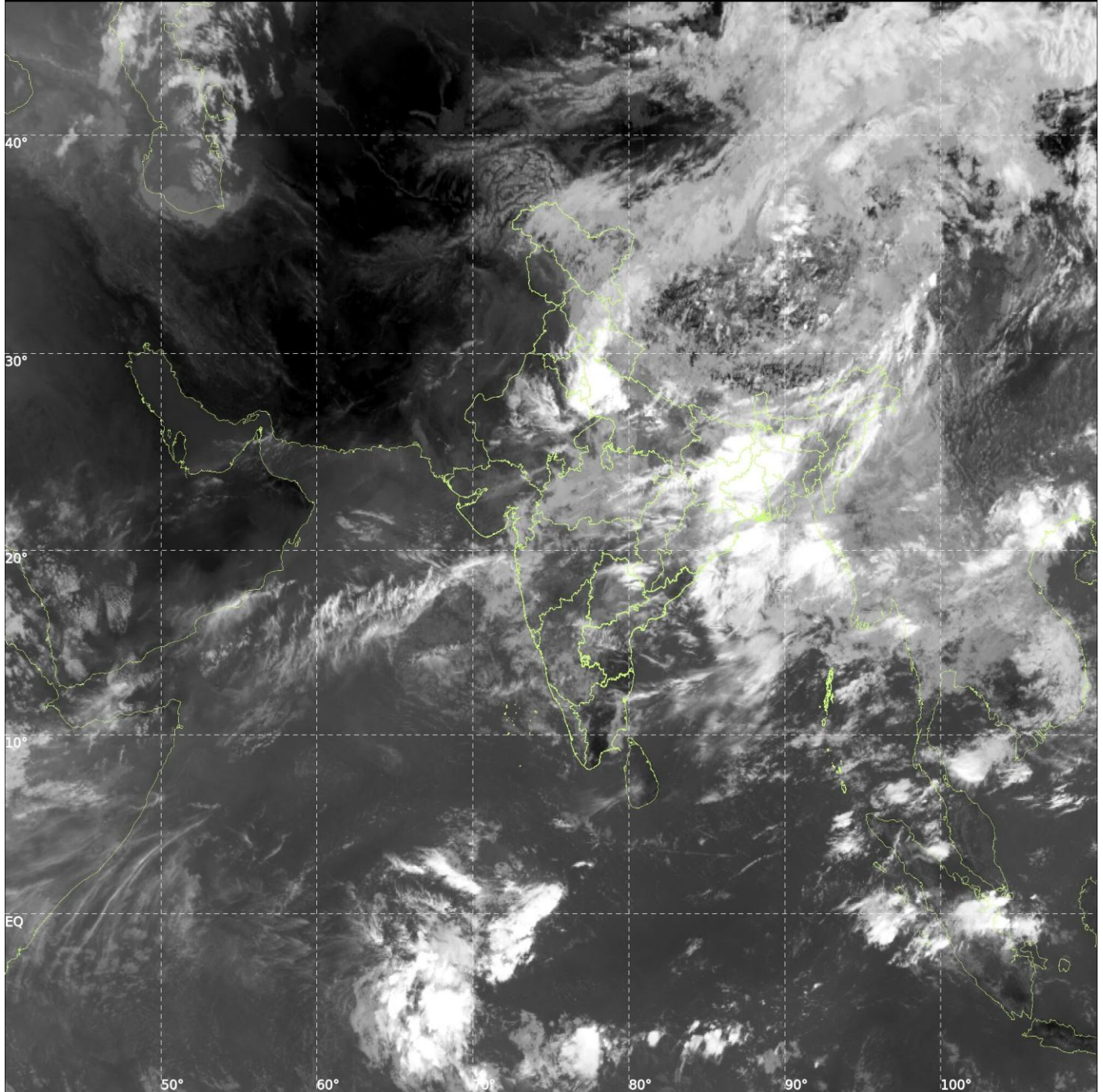
