BAY OF BENGAL:

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL & ANDAMAN SEA AND MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER WESTCENTRAL & SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL.

ARABIAN SEA:

YESTERDAY'S LOW PRESSURE AREA OVER COASTAL AREAS OF KUTCH AND NEIGHBOURHOOD HAS BECOME LESS MARKED AT 0300 UTC OF TODAY, THE 15th JULY 2021.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER NORTHEAST ARABIAN SEA ADJOINING KUTCH AREA & NEIGHBOURHOOD.

SCATTERED LOW AND MEDIUM CLOUDS WITH EMBEDDED INTENSE TO VERY INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER NORTH & EASTCENTRAL ARABIAN SEA AND MODERATE TO INTENSE CONVECTION LAY OVER SOUTHEAST ARABIAN SEA.
