DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 10.09.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 10.09.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 10.09.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Under the influence of yesterday's cyclonic circulation over North Bay of Bengal & adjoining Bangladesh coast a Low Pressure Area formed over North Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood at 0000 UTC and lay over the same region at 0300 UTC of today's, 10th September, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extended upto 9.4 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height.

Scattered to broken, low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over Bay of Bengal and south Andaman Sea. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated moderate to intense convection lay over north Andaman Sea.

Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over south Arabian Sea to the south of latitude 10.0°N, Maldives & Comorin area. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated weak convection lay over rest of Arabian Sea & Lakshadweep islands area.

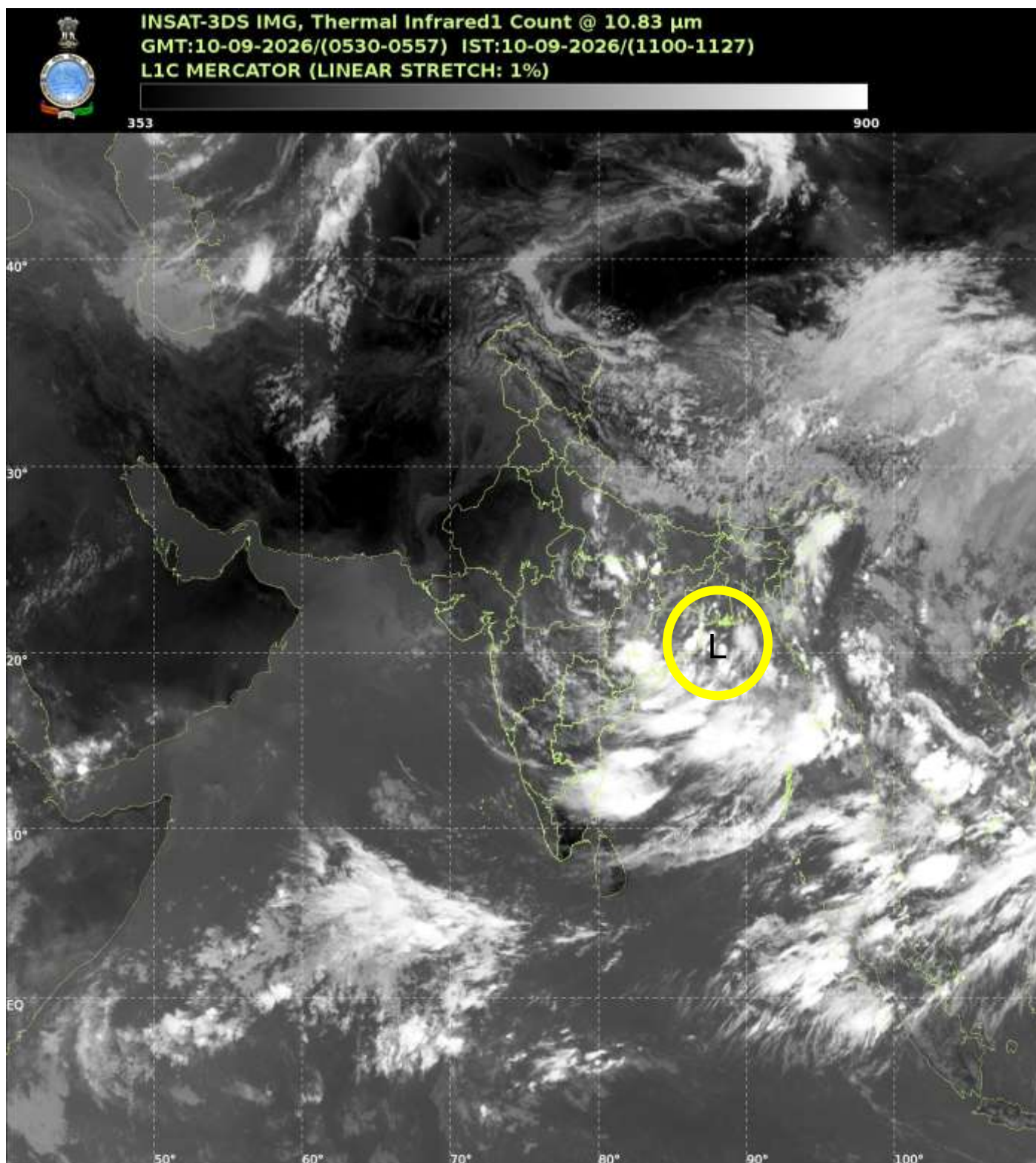
