Sub: Depression over north coastal Andhra Pradesh & adjoining south Odisha

An upper-air cyclonic circulation over north Thailand emerged over north Andaman Sea & neighbourhood extended up to 7.6 km above mean sea level at 1730 hrs IST of 18th September, 2026. Under its influence a Low-Pressure area formed over the same region at 1730 hrs IST of 19th September, 2026. It lay as a Well-Marked Low-Pressure area over Eastcentral & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal at 0530 hrs IST of 21st September, 2026.

Thereafter, the well-marked low-pressure area moved west-northwestwards intensified into a Depression over Westcentral & adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal at 1730 hrs IST of 21st September, 2026. The Depression gradually moved west-northwestwards and intensified into a deep depression over the same region at 1730 hrs IST of 22nd September, 2026. Subsequently, the Deep Depression moved slowly west-northwestwards and crossed the coast closed to southwest of Kalingapatnam during 2300 hrs IST of 23rd and 0100 hrs IST of 24th September 2026, as a Deep Depression with maximum sustained wind speed of 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph. The system lay centred at 1130 hrs IST of today, 24th September 2026 over north coastal Andhra Pradesh & adjoining south Odisha about 70 km west-northwest of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), 80 km south-southeast of Rayagada (Odisha), 90 km east-southeast of Koraput (Odisha) and 170 km east-southeast of Jagdalpur (Chhattisgarh). It is very likely to move north-northwestwards and weaken gradually into a Depression around evening of today, the 24th September. Thereafter it is very likely to continue to move north-northwestwards and weaken gradually during subsequent 24 hours.

i. Rainfall Warning:

Odisha: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** with **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Odisha and isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall over north Odisha on 24th September. **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 25th over interior Odisha and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Odisha is likely on 26th September.

Chhattisgarh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places and **extremely heavy rainfall** at isolated places over south Chhattisgarh and isolated **heavy to very heavy rainfall** over north Chhattisgarh on 24th September. **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 25th and isolated **heavy rainfall** on 26th September over Chhattisgarh.

Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Yanam: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam on 24th September and **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places over north Coastal Andhra Pradesh is likely on 25th September.

Telangana: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places over northeast Telangana very likely on 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over east Telangana on 25th September.

Jharkhand: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th September.

Gangetic West Bengal: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 24th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 25th September.

East Madhya Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places during 24th-27th and **isolated very heavy rainfall** is very likely on 25th & 26th September.

Vidarbha: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with **heavy to very rainfall** at isolated places on 24th & 25th September and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places is very likely on 26th September.

ii. Wind warning:

- Squally wind with speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is prevailing over Westcentral and adjoining Northwest Bay of Bengal & along and off south Odisha-north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts and likely to continue till noon and become 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph in the evening of today, the 24th September. It is likely to become 45-55 kmph gusting to 65kmph from midnight of today, 24th September till morning of 25th September and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Squally wind with speed reaching 55-65 kmph gusting to 75 kmph is prevailing over coastal districts of north Andhra Pradesh & adjoining east Telangana, south Odisha and south Chhattisgarh and likely to continue till noon and becoming 50-60 kmph gusting to

70 kmph in the evening of today, the 24th September. It is likely to become 45-55 kmph gusting to 65kmph from midnight of today, 24th September till morning of 25th September and decrease gradually thereafter.

- Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over the districts of northwest Odisha, north Chhattisgarh and southwest Jharkhand from 24th evening till 25th evening and decrease gradually thereafter.
- Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over adjoining areas of North and South Bay of Bengal till evening of today, the 24rd September.
- Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely along & off West Bengal and south Andhra Pradesh & Yanam coasts till evening of today, the 24rd September.

iii. Sea condition:

- Very Rough to rough sea condition is prevailing over westcentral & northwest Bay of Bengal till noon and likely to become rough from evening of today, the 24th September till morning of 25th September and improve gradually thereafter.
- Very Rough to rough sea condition is prevailing along & off north Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till noon and likely to become rough from evening of today, the 24th September till morning of 25th September and improve gradually thereafter.
- Rough sea condition is likely over adjoining areas of southwest Bay of Bengal till 24th September evening and gradually improve thereafter.

iv. Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into

- Westcentral & adjoining northwest & southwest Bay of Bengal and along & off Andhra Pradesh-Odisha-West Bengal coasts till morning of 25th September.

v. Impact expected (Coastal districts of north Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and south Odisha for squally wind & heavy rainfall; interior districts of Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Telangana, Chhattisgarh, Vidarbha, East Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand for heavy rainfall):

- Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks.
- Loose objects may fly.
- Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- Onshore and offshore operations may get affected.
- Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips in hilly areas and water logging, inundation and flooding over low-lying areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Helicopter services may get affected.

Action suggested:

- People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly. People may stay in safe places especially during 23rd to 24th September.
- Fishing operation may be suspended till 24th September.
- Surface transport may be regulated.
- Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- Helicopter services to be regulated.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

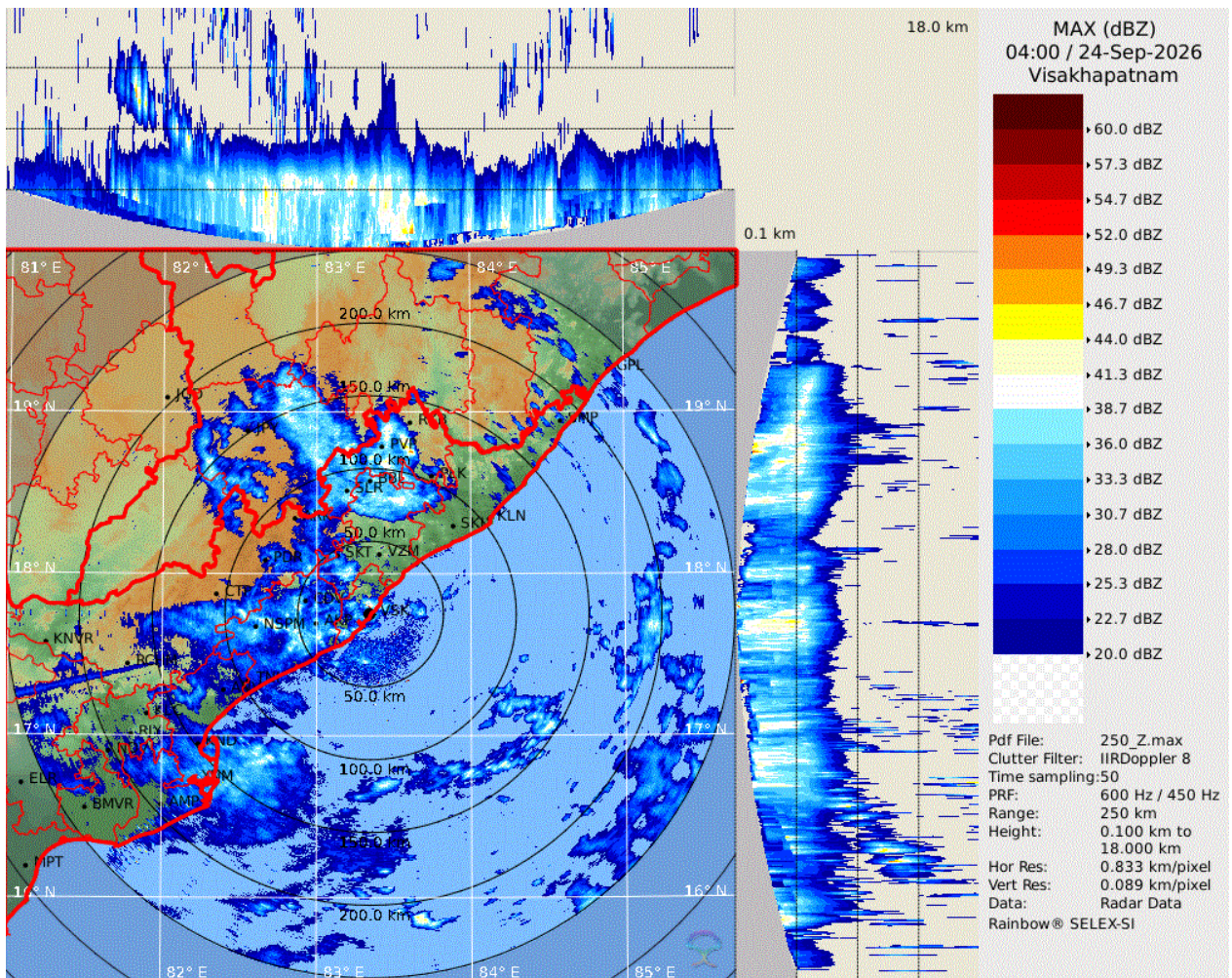

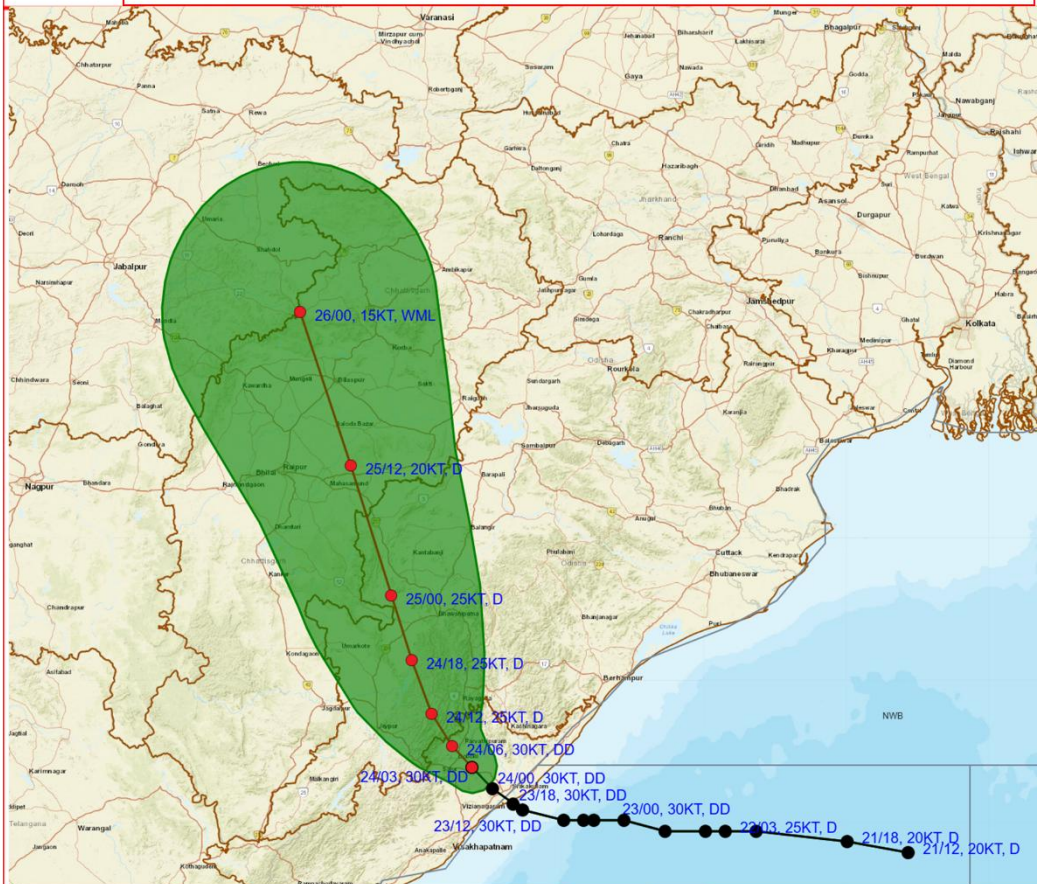

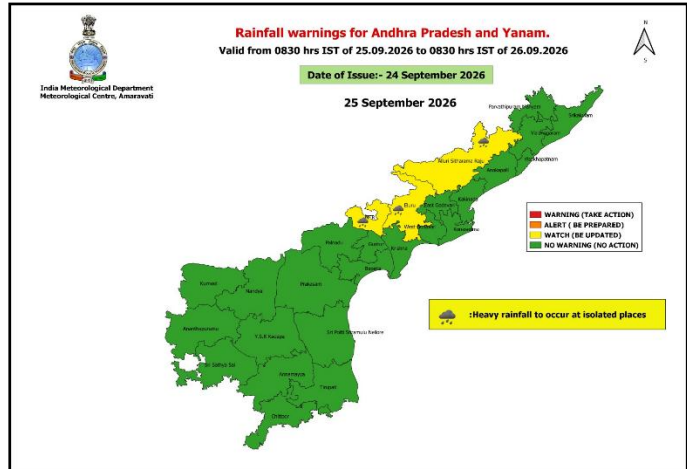
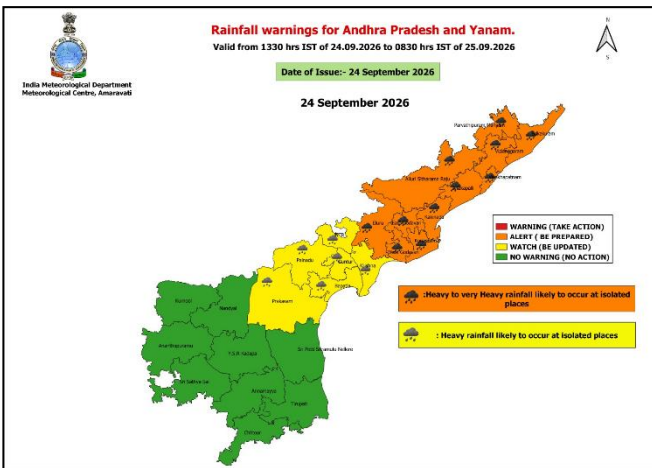




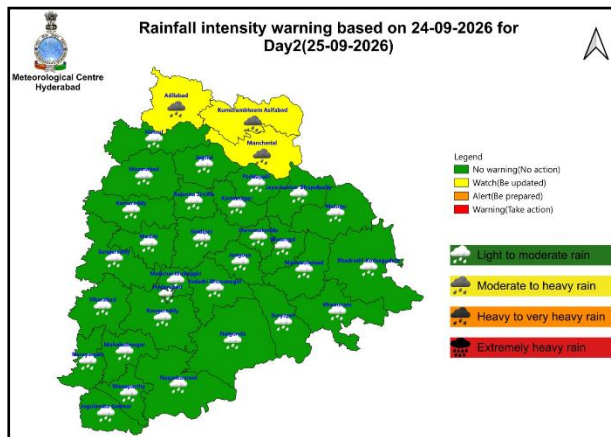
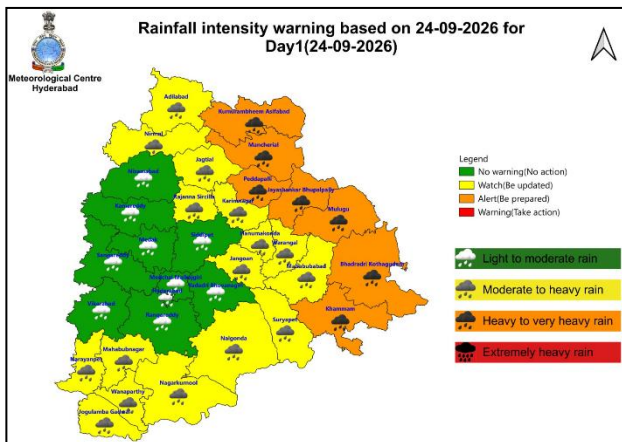
District-wise Rainfall Warning for the State of Odisha



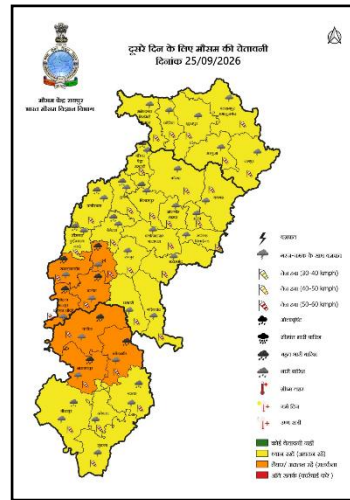
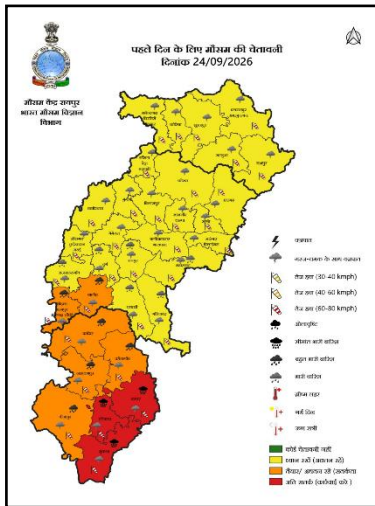
District-wise Rainfall Warning for the State of Andhra Pradesh

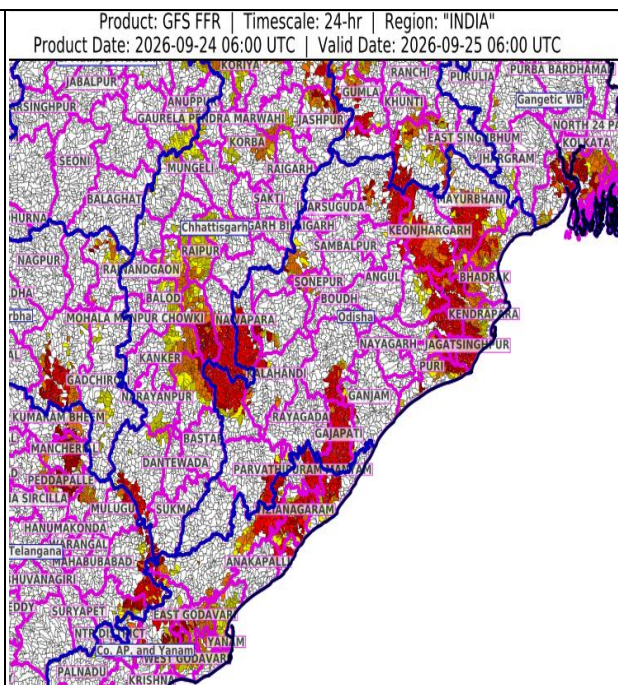
