Sub: Well Marked Low Pressure Area over northern parts of central Uttar Pradesh

Yesterday's Depression over Northeast Madhya Pradesh & adjoining north Chhattisgarh moved north-northwestwards and weakened into a well marked low pressure area over northern parts of central Uttar Pradesh in the early morning (0530 hrs IST) and persisted over the same region at 0830 hours IST of today, the 27th September 2026.

It is very likely to move north-northwestwards across Uttar Pradesh and weaken gradually into a Low Pressure Area during next 12 hours. The system is under continuous surveillance by Doppler Weather Radar at Lucknow

Warnings:

(i) Rainfall Warning:

East Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 27th September.

West Uttar Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 27th September.

Himachal Pradesh: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 27th September.

Uttarakhand: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with **heavy to very heavy rainfall** at a few places is very likely on 27th and **heavy rainfall** at isolated places on 28th September.

(ii) Wind warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph is likely to prevail over north Uttar Pradesh & adjoining areas of Uttarakhand on 27th September and decrease gradually thereafter.

(iii) Impact expected (Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh for heavy rainfall):

- ❖ Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks.
- ❖ Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- ❖ Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong wind & heavy rain.
- ❖ Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- ❖ Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- ❖ There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips in hilly areas and water logging, inundation and flooding over low-lying areas.
- ❖ Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- ❖ Helicopter services may get affected.

(iv) Action suggested:

- ❖ People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly. People may stay in safe places.
- ❖ Surface transport, Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- ❖ Helicopter services to be regulated.
- ❖ Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- ❖ In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.

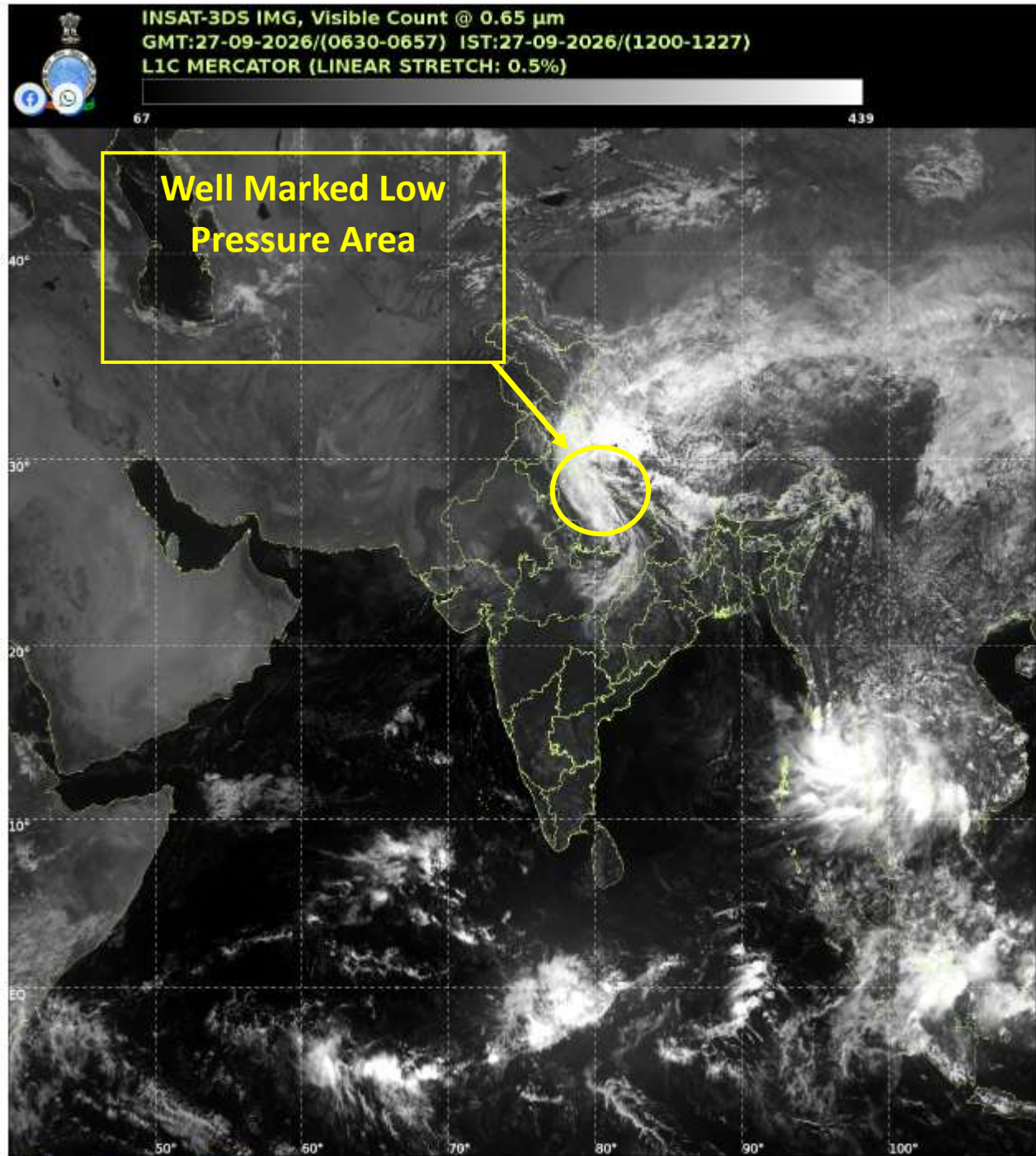

It is likely to become 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph over northeast Madhya Pradesh and adjoining south Uttar Pradesh, north Chhattisgarh, southwest Jharkhand, & West Bihar from evening of 26 th and 25-35 kmph gusting to 45 kmph over Uttar Pradesh & adjoining areas of north Madhya Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 27 th September and decrease gradually thereafter. 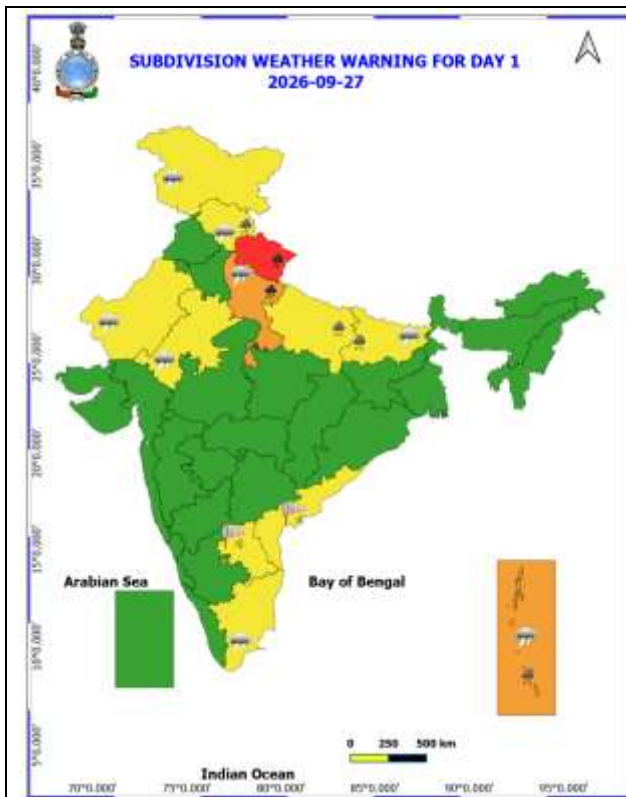

Flash Flood Guidance

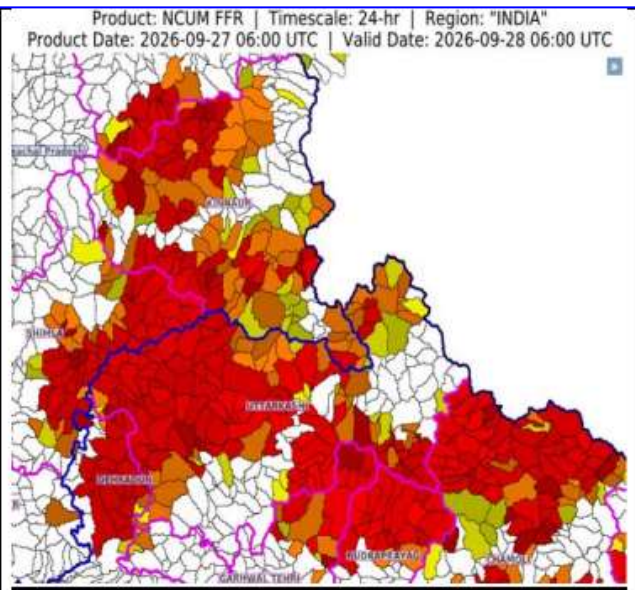
Flash Flood Risk (FFR) till 1130 IST of 28-09-2026:

Low to Moderate flash flood risk likely over few watersheds & neighbourhoods of following Met Sub-divisions during next 24 hours.

Himachal Pradesh: Kinnaur, Shimla and Sirmaur districts

Uttarakhand: Uttarkashi, Dehradun, Garhwal Tehri, Chamoli and Rudraprayag districts

Surface runoff/ Inundation may occur at some fully saturated soils & low-lying areas over Area of Concern (AoC) as shown in map due to expected rainfall occurrence in next 24 hours.
