Fishermen Warning for Next Five Days

Warning for Fishermen West Bengal Coast for next 5 days commencing from 30/06/2025

FISHERMEN WARNING FOR WEST BENGAL COAST FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS: THE LOW-PRESSURE AREA OVER COASTAL GANGETIC WEST BENGAL & NEIGHBOURHOOD LAY OVER GANGETIC WEST BENGAL AT 1730 HRS IST OF TODAY, THE 30TH JUNE 2025. THE ASSOCIATED CYCLONIC CIRCULATION EXTENDED UPTO 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL. UNDER ITS INFLUENCE SQUALLY WEATHER WITH SURFACE WIND SPEED REACHING 35–45 KMPH GUSTING UP TO 55 KMPH VERY LIKELY ALONG AND OFF WEST BENGAL-ODISHA COAST, NORTH BAY AND ADJOINING WEST CENTRAL BAY OF BENGAL DURING 30-06-2025 TO 02-07-2025. SEA CONDITION LIKELY TO BE ROUGH TO VERY ROUGH. FISHERMEN ARE ADVISED NOT TO VENTURE INTO THE NORTH BAY, ADJOINING WEST CENTRAL BAY OF BENGAL AND ALONG AND OFF WEST BENGAL-ODISHA COAST TILL 02ND JULY 2025.

FISHERMEN WARNING FOR ANDAMAN & NICOBAR COAST FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS: SQUALLY WEATHER WITH SURFACE WIND SPEED REACHING 35–45 KMPH GUSTING UP TO 55 KMPH VERY LIKELY OVER ANDAMAN SEA AND ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS FROM 30-06-2025 TO 02-07-2025. SEA CONDITION LIKELY TO BE ROUGH TO VERY ROUGH. FISHERMEN ARE ADVISED NOT TO VENTURE INTO THE SEA ALONG AND OFF ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS FROM 30-06-2025 TO 02-07-2025.
