



Warning for Fishermen

26/08/2026 / 0600 HRS IST

Synoptic situation: The Low-Pressure Area over Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining areas of Jharkhand and North Odisha lay over north Odisha & adjoining Jharkhand and Gangetic West Bengal at 1730 Hrs IST of 24th August 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation now extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. The system is likely to move nearly north-westwards across Jharkhand & north Odisha during the next 24 hours.

Weather warning for fishermen for Andhra coast valid for next four (4) days commencing from 0600 hours IST of 26/08/2026:

Day 1 (26/08/2026): Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail off North Andhra Pradesh coast and Yanam.

Day 2 (27/08/2026) to Day 4 (29/08/2026): Nil.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas during the above mentioned period.

Weather warning for fishermen for Bay of Bengal (other than Andhra coast):

Day 1 (26/08/2026): Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Tamilnadu coast and over some parts of southwest, some parts of westcentral and southeast Bay of Bengal.

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over southeast adjoining eastcentral Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

Day 2 (27/08/2026): Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Tamilnadu coast and over some parts of southwest Bay of Bengal.

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over Andaman Sea.

Day 3 (28/08/2026): Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Tamilnadu coast and over some parts of southwest Bay of Bengal

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of central & southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

Day 4 (29/08/2026): Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Tamilnadu coast and over some parts of southwest Bay of Bengal

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of central & southeast Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.

Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea areas during the above mentioned period.

EAST GODAVARI: Ocean Currents Alert for the coast of EAST GODAVARI, ANDHRA PRADESH from Antarvedi To Perumallapuram. Surface current speeds in the range of 1.1 - 1.5 m/sec are forecasted during 16:00 hours on 25-08-2026 to 13:00 hours on 27-08-2026. It advised that Harbour & marine operations to be careful.

GUNTUR: Ocean Currents Alert for the coast of GUNTUR, ANDHRA PRADESH from Bestapalem Bapatla To Nizampatnam. Surface current speeds in the range of 0.8 - 1.2 m/sec are forecasted during 01:00 hours on 26-08-2026 to 07:00 hours on 27-08-2026. It advised that Harbour & marine operations to be careful.

KRISHNA: Ocean Currents Alert for the coast of KRISHNA, ANDHRA PRADESH from Nachugunta To Pedda Gollapalem. Surface current speeds in the range of 1.2 - 1.5 m/sec are forecasted during 16:00 hours on 25-08-2026 to 16:00 hours on 27-08-2026. It advised that Harbour & marine operations to be careful.
