Fishermen Warning for Maharashtra - Goa Coast

Valid For Next Five Days From 01-Nov-2025 to 05-Nov-2025

Warning for coastal areas for North- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Konkan coast from 31 st Oct to 01 st Nov. 2025. Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off the coast during this period.

Warning for coastal areas for South Maharashtra-Goa coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Warning for High Sea and other coasts (Beyond 75km from the coast) :-

Wind warning :-

Day 1 (01-Nov-2025):	Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off Gujarat coast and adjoining sea areas, over many parts of Eastcentral, Northeast Arabian Sea. Squally weather with wind speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to prevail over some parts of Eastcentral and adjoining northeast Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during this period.
Day 2 (02-Nov-2025):	Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off Gujarat coasts and adjoining sea areas, over many parts of Eastcentral, Northeast Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during this period.
Day 3 (03-Nov-2025):	Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off Gujarat coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during this period.
Day 4 (04-Nov-2025):	Nil.
Day 5 (05-Nov-2025):	Nil.

Wind warning:

Squally wind with speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over Eastcentral & northeast Arabian Sea around the system center and along & off Maharashtra and Gujarat coasts till morning of 1 st November; thereafter, it would decrease becoming 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph on 1 st November.

Sea condition:

Sea Condition is likely to be very rough to rough over Eastcentral and northeast Arabian Sea & along & off Maharashtra and Gujarat coasts till 1 st November.

Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Eastcentral & northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Maharashtra and Gujarat coasts till 1 st November.

Port Warning for North Maharashtra coast :-

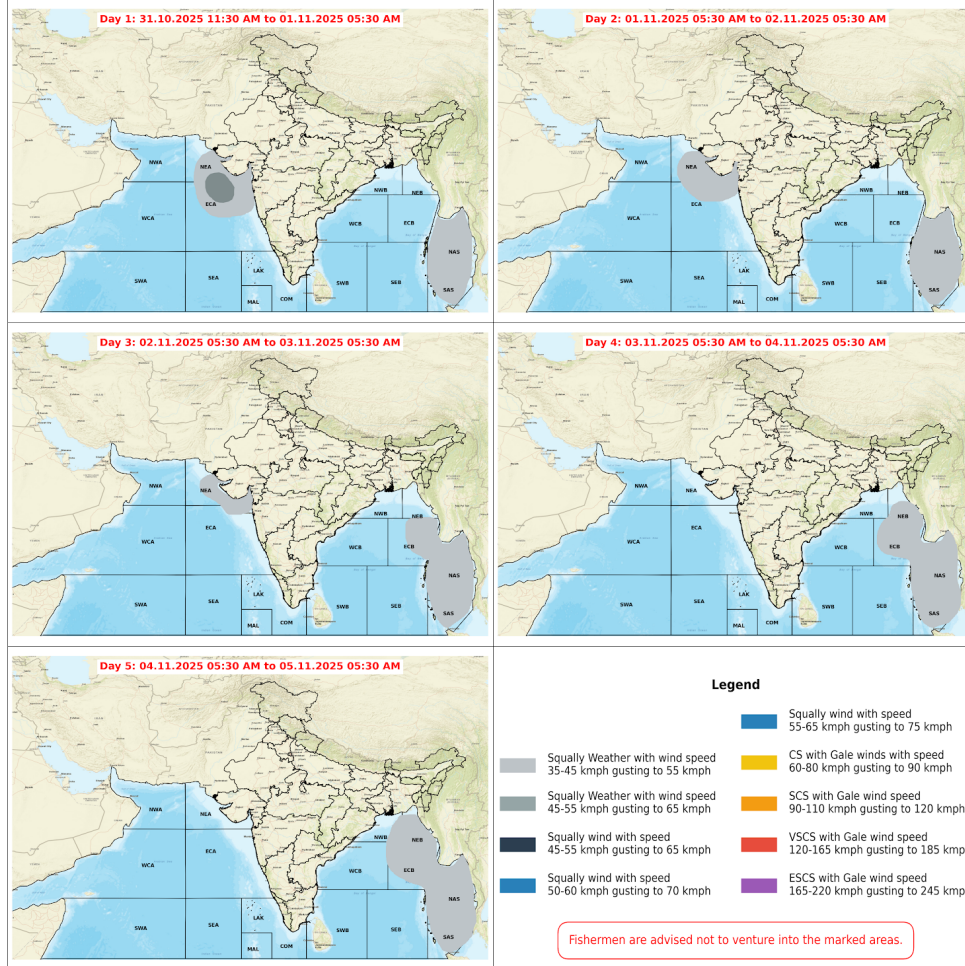
The Depression over eastcentral Arabian Sea moved east-northeastwards with a speed of 12 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 2330 hrs IST of yesterday, the 31 st October 2025, over the same region, near latitude 19.4°N & longitude 69.6°E, about 190 km south- southwest of Veraval (Gujarat), 200 km southwest of Diu, 340 km west of Mumbai (Maharashtra) and 620 km northwest of Panjim (Goa). It is likely to continue to move east-northeastwards towards Gujarat coast across northeast Arabian Sea and weaken into a Well-Marked Low-Pressure Area during next 12 hours.
Keep hoisted Local Cautionary Signal No III (repeat LC -III) at all ports from Dahanu to Srivardhan off North Maharashtra Coast.

Port Warning for South Maharashtra-Goa coast :-

The Depression over eastcentral Arabian Sea moved east-northeastwards with a speed of 12 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centered at 2330 hrs IST of yesterday, the 31 st October 2025, over the same region, near latitude 19.4°N & longitude 69.6°E, about 190 km south- southwest of Veraval (Gujarat), 200 km southwest of Diu, 340 km west of Mumbai (Maharashtra) and 620 km northwest of Panjim (Goa).
