FISHERMEN WARNING FOR WEST BENGAL

DATE: 2026-07-16

TIME OF ISSUE: 1230 IST

SYNOPTIC SITUATION:

The low pressure over Northwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining North Odisha -West Bengal coasts now lay as a Well-marked low pressure area over the same region at 0830 hrs IST of today, 16th July, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extending upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height. It is very likely to move northwestwards across North Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal during next 2 days.

Southwest Monsoon Moderate to Strong over North & Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and North Andaman Sea; Moderate over Westcentral & South Bay of Bengal and South Andaman Sea.

FISHERMEN WARNING:

West Bengal: SQUALLY WIND WITH SPEED REACHING 35 - 45 KMPH OCCASIONALLY GUSTING 55 KMPH IS LIKELY TO PREVAIL ALONG AND OFF WEST BENGAL & NORTH ODISHA COASTS FROM 16-07-2026 TO 17-07-2026. FISHERMEN ARE ADVISED NOT TO VENTURE INTO THE SEA ALONG AND OFF WEST BENGAL & NORTH ODISHA COAST FROM 16-07-2026 TO 17-07-2026.
