Fishermen Warning for Maharashtra - Goa Coast
(Valid for next five days from 24/06/2022 to 28/06/2022)

Warning for coastal areas for North- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off North Maharashtra coast during 24TH June to 26TH June 2022.
Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off North Maharashtra coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for coastal areas for South- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during 24TH June to 28TH June 2022.
Fishermen are advised not to venture along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for High Sea and other coasts (Beyond 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Gujarat coast and adjoining Northeast Arabian sea during 24th June to 26th June 2022.
Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Karnataka coast and adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea during 24th June to 28TH June 2022.
Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Kerala coast and adjoining Southeast Arabian sea on 24th June and 28TH June 2022.
Strong wind with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail along and off South Gujarat coast and adjoining Northeast Arabian sea during 24th June to 26th June 2022.
Strong wind with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over parts of Eastcentral Arabian sea during 24th June to 28TH June 2022.
Strong wind with wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph is likely to prevail over parts of Southwest Arabian sea and adjoining West central Arabian sea during 24th June to 28TH June 2022.
Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas during above mentioned period.

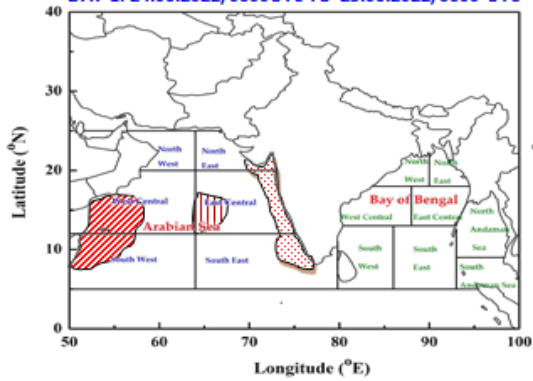
High Wave alerts from INCOIS:-

High waves in the range of 2.9 - 3.3 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 23-06-2022 to 23:30 hours of 25-06-2022 along the coast from Malvan to Vasai of Maharashtra coast.
High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 23-06-2022 to 23:30 hours of 25-06-2022 along the coast of Goa between Vengurla to Vasco.
High swell waves in the range of 2.5 - 2.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 23-06-2022 to 23:30 hours of 24-06-2022 along the coast from Jakhau to Diu Head of Gujarat coast.

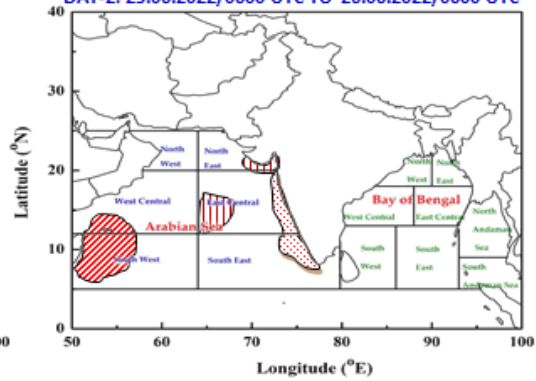

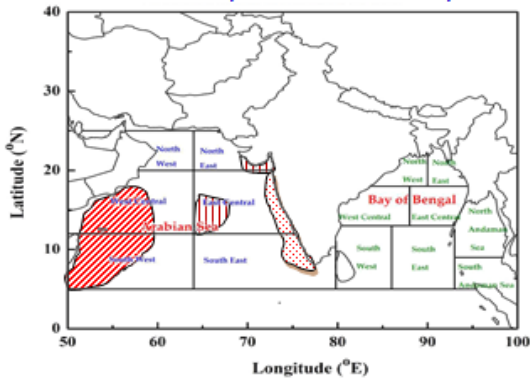
DAY-1: 24.06.2022/0600UTC TO 25.06.2022/0600 UTC



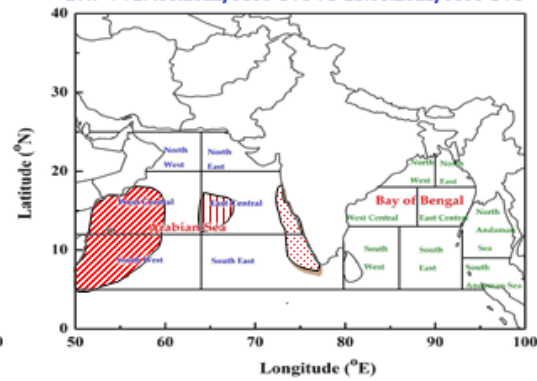
DAY-2: 25.06.2022/0600 UTC TO 26.06.2022/0600 UTC



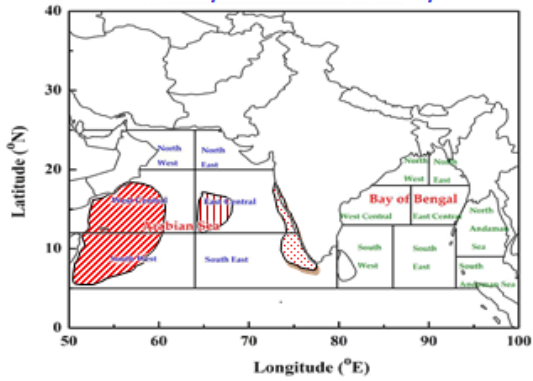
DAY-3: 26.06.2022/0600 UTC TO 27.06.2022/0600 UTC
