FISHERMEN WARNING FOR WEST BENGAL AND ANDAMAN & NICOBAR COASTS

DATE: 2026-06-03

TIME OF ISSUE: 0530 IST

SYNOPTIC SITUATION:

The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 10°N/60°E, 9°/65°E, 8.5°N/70°E, 8°N/75°E, 7.8°N/78°E, 8°N/80°E, 10°N/80°E, 13°N/87°E, 16°N/90°E, 19°N/93°E and 22°N/97°E.

Conditions are favourable for further advance of southwest monsoon into some more parts of southwest, westcentral, eastcentral & northeast Bay of Bengal, and remaining parts of southeast Bay of Bengal around 4th June.

Southwest Monsoon Moderate over Andaman Sea and most parts of South East Bay of Bengal and some parts of West Central & South West Bay of Bengal; Weak to Moderate over some parts over Northeast & East Central Bay of Bengal.

The upper air cyclonic circulation over northeast & adjoining eastcentral Bay of Bengal & extending upto 4.5 km above mean sea level persists.

Andaman & Nicobar: FISHERMEN WARNING FOR ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR COAST DURING NEXT SEVEN DAYS: DUE TO SQUALLY WIND WITH SPEED REACHING 40 - 50 KMPH OCCASIONALLY GUSTING 60 KMPH IS LIKELY TO PREVAIL ALONG AND OFF ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR COAST FROM 03/06/2026 TO 04/06/2026. FISHERMEN ARE ADVISED NOT TO VENTURE IN TO THE SEA ALONG AND OFF ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR COAST FROM 03/06/2026 TO 04/06/2026.

SWELL SURGE ALERT:

Andaman & Nicobar: Swell waves in the range of 17.0 - 18.0 sec period with 1.3 - 1.5 m height are forecasted during 11:30 hours on 03-06-2026 to 20:30 hours on 04-06-2026. It advised that there is a possibility of surging of waves, boats to ply with utmost vigilance, recreation with due care
