Fishermen Warning for Maharashtra - Goa Coast

Valid For Next Five Days From 19-Jun-2025 to 23-Jun-2025

Warning for coastal areas for North- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Maharashtra coast on from 19th June to 20th June 2025 .

Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.

Warning for coastal areas for South Maharashtra-Goa coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally weather with wind speed 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast on from 19th June to 20th June 2025 .

Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.

Warning for High Sea and other coasts (Beyond 75km from the coast) :-

North Maharashtra:	<p>THANE, MUMBAI SUBURBAN, MUMBAI CITY, MAHARASHTRA from Dongi Point To Belapur. High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 19-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p> <p>PALGHAR, MAHARASHTRA from Zai To Vasai. High waves in the range of 3.3 - 3.6 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that to be careful while doing marine operations and nearshore recreation.</p> <p>RAIGARH, MAHARASHTRA from Ulwa Moha To Bagmandla. High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 19-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p>
South Maharashtra:	<p>RATNAGIRI, MAHARASHTRA from Veshawi-Bankot To Jambhari. High waves in the range of 3.7 - 4.0 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 08:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p> <p>SINDHUDURG, MAHARASHTRA from Vijayadurg Hr To Terekhol. High waves in the range of 3.6 - 3.9 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 08:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p>
Goa:	<p>High Wave Warning for the coast of NORTH GOA, GOA from Chapora To Panaji (Malim). High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 05:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p> <p>High Wave Warning for the coast of GIR SOMNATH,GUJARAT from Adri To Mul Dwaraka. High waves in the range of 3.8 - 3.9 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p> <p>High Wave Warning for the coast of JUNAGADH SOUTH,GUJARAT from Nava Bandar To Saiyad Rajpara. High waves in the range of 3.4 - 3.5 meters are forecasted during 02:30 hours on 19-06-2025 to 08:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible.</p> <p>High Wave Alert for the coast of KACHCHH,GUJARAT from Lakhapat To Kandla. High waves in the range of 3.1 - 3.2 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that to be careful while doing marine operations and nearshore recreation.</p> <p>High Wave Warning for the coast of PORBANDAR,GUJARAT from Tukda Miyani To Madhavpur. High waves in the range of 3.8 - 3.9 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 18-06-2025 to 23:30 hours on 20-06-2025. It advised that small vessels not to ply, nearshore recreation activities to be totally suspended, and erosion/wave surges possible</p>

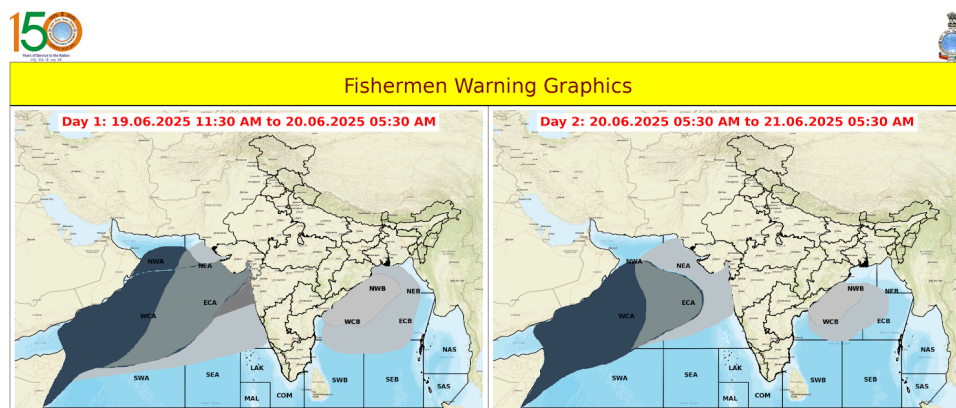
Port Warning for North Maharashtra coast :-

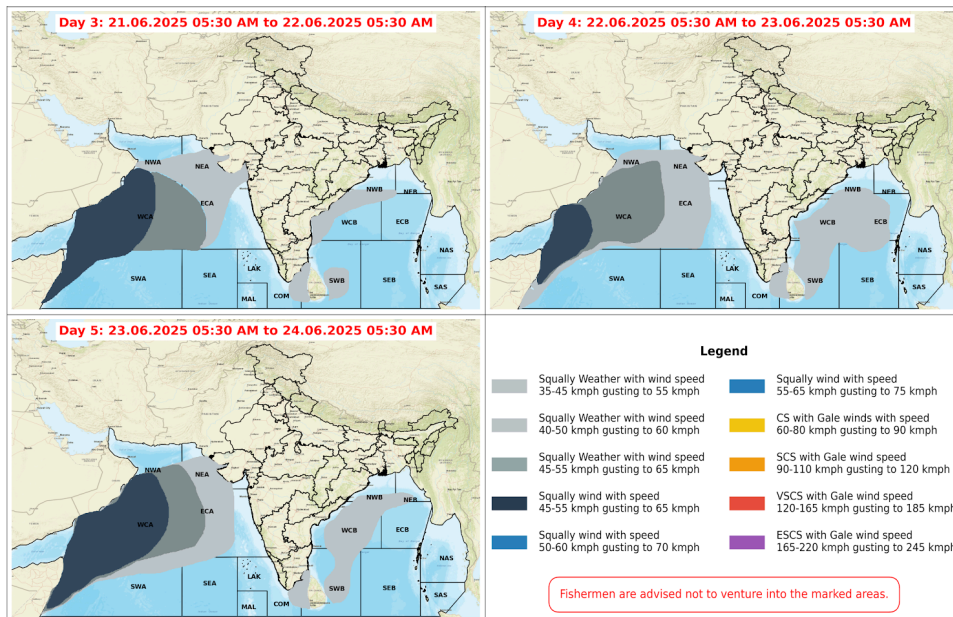
Under the influence of Squally weather with wind speed 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Maharashtra coast , Keep Hoisting LOCAL CAUTIONARY signal no III (LC III) rpt signal no III (LC III) from all ports from Dahanu to Shriwardan off North Maharashtra coast.

Port Warning for South Maharashtra-Goa coast :-

Under the influence of Squally weather with wind speed 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off South Maharashtra-Goa coast. Keep Hoisting LOCAL CAUTIONARY signal no III (LC III) rpt signal no III (LC III) from all ports from Bankhot to Marmugao off South Maharashtra-Goa coast.
