**FISHERMEN WARNING FOR WEST BENGAL AND ANDAMAN & NICOBAR
COASTS**

DATE: 2026-09-28

TIME OF ISSUE: 2030 IST

SYNOPTIC SITUATION:

The Deep Depression over north Andaman Sea & adjoining Myanmar coast moved north-northwestwards with a speed of 10 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centred at 1730 hrs IST of today, the 28th September 2026 over the same region close to coast near latitude 16.9°N and longitude 97.2°E, about 50 km south-southeast of Kyaikto (Myanmar), 60 km northwest of Mawlanyine (Myanmar), 90 km southeast of Bago (Myanmar), 110 km east of Yangon (Myanmar) and 630 km northeast of Mayabandar (Andaman Islands, India). The land interaction has already commenced over Irrawaddy Delta region and the deep depression is very likely to cross Myanmar coast between Yangon and Kyaikto, close to Kyaikto during next 2-3 hours. After the landfall, it is likely to continue to move further north-northwestwards across coastal Myanmar and adjoining Eastcentral & Northeast Bay of Bengal and southeast Bangladesh during next 2 days.

FISHERMEN WARNING:

West Bengal: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over Myanmar-Bangladesh coasts and adjoining areas of Eastcentral & northeast Bay of Bengal from 28th evening to 30th September evening. No warning for West Bengal coast, however Fishermen are advised not to venture into deep sea over Northeast Bay of Bengal and along and off Bangladesh coast from 29th to 30th September 2026.

Andaman & Nicobar: Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45- 55 kmph gusting 65 kmph is likely to prevail over North Andaman sea & along and off Andaman Island, North Andaman Sea adjoining East Central Bay of Bengal on 28-09-2026. Fishermen are advised not to venture into North Andaman Sea & along and off Andaman Island, North Andaman Sea adjoining East Central Bay of Bengal on 28-09-2026.

SWELL SURGE ALERT:

West Bengal: Swell waves in the range of 16.0 - 18.0 sec period with 1.1 - 2.0 m height are forecasted up to 23:30 hours on 30-09-2026. It advised that there is a possibility of surging of waves, boats to ply with utmost vigilance, recreation with due care.

Andaman & Nicobar: Swell waves in the range of 16.0 - 18.0 sec period with 1.1 - 1.3 m height are forecasted up to 23:30 hours on 29-09-2026. It advised that there is a possibility of surging of waves, boats to ply with utmost vigilance, recreation with due care.
