Synoptic Situation:- Due to steep pressure gradient strong wind along and off Gujarat coast very likely to prevail.

1. Fishermen warning for North Gujarat coast (Jakhau, Mandvi (Kutch), Mundra, New Kandla, Navlakhi, Salaya, Okha, Bedi, Sikka(Jamnagar), Porbandar)

DAY 1- Strong wind speed 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph is very likely to prevail from South Westerly to Westerly direction along & off North Gujarat coast. Sea will be rough with waves from South Westerly to Westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast.

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over eastcentral Arabian Sea.

DAY 3- Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia & Oman coast, most parts of westcentral, & some parts of southwest adjoining few parts of north & eastcentral Arabian Sea.

Squally Weather with wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over eastcentral Arabian Sea.

DAY 4- Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia & Oman coast, most parts of westcentral and some parts of southwest adjoining few parts of north & eastcentral Arabian Sea.

DAY 5- Squally wind with speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia coast, most parts of westcentral and some parts of southwest adjoining adjoining few parts of north & eastcentral Arabian Sea.
