(For 5 days from 06th September 2025 to 10th September 2025)

SYNOPTIC SITUATION:-Due to vigorous monsoon conditions squally weather very likely to prevail along and off North and South Gujarat Coast.

1) Fishermen warning for North Gujarat coast (Jakhau, Mandvi (Kutch), Mundra, New Kandla, Navlakhi, Jamnagar, Salaya, Okha, Porbandar)

DAY 1-Squally weather with wind speed reaching 45 - 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph likely to prevail from Westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast. Sea will be high with waves from Westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast.

DAY 2-Squally weather with wind speed 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph very likely to prevail along and off North Gujarat coast.

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Gujarat coasts.

DAY 2-Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia coastsand Oman coasts, many parts of westcentral Arabian Sea, some parts of southwestArabian sea, & adjoining few parts of northwest Arabian sea.

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over many parts of northeast Arabian sea, some parts of northwest Arabian sea, few parts of eastcentral Arabian sea.

DAY 3-Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia coastsand Oman coasts, many parts of westcentral, some parts of southwest Arabian Sea, fewparts of northwest&eastcentral Arabian sea.

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over some parts of northeast Arabian Sea, some parts of eastcentral, few parts of northwest Arabian Sea.

DAY 4-Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somaliaand Oman coasts, many parts of westcentralSea &some parts of southwestArabian Sea.

DAY 5-Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somaliaand Oman coasts, some parts of southwest&westcentral Arabian Sea.
