Fishermen Warning for Maharashtra - Goa Coast

(Valid for next five days from 10/06/2023 to 14/06/2023)

Warning for coastal areas for North- Maharashtra coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely along & off North Maharashtra coast on 10th to 13th June.

Fishermen are advised not to venture along & off North Maharashtra coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for coastal areas for South Maharashtra-Goa coast (upto 75km from the coast) :-

Squally wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely along & off South Maharashtra-Goa coast on 10th to 13th June.

Fishermen are advised not to venture along & off South Maharashtra-Goa coast during above mentioned period.

Warning for High Sea and other coasts (Beyond 75km from the coast) :-

Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over Gulf of Mannar and parts of Comorin area. |

| Day 3: 12-06-2023 | Gale wind speed reaching 145-155 kmph gusting to 170 kmph is likely to prevail over northeast and adjoining central Arabian Sea and becoming 135-145 kmph gusting to 160 kmph from evening. Squally wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely along & off Karnataka, Kerala coast, parts of Lakshadweep area and parts of Comorin and Maldives area. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over Gulf of Mannar parts of Comorin area. |

Gale wind speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph over adjoining areas of central Arabian Sea.</p> <p>Squally wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely along & off Karnataka, Kerala coast, parts of Lakshadweep area and Comorin.</p> <p>Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely over Gulf of Mannar and parts of Comorin area.</p> |
| <p>Along & off Saurashtra & Kutch coasts:</p> <p>Squally wind speed reaching 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail on 10 th June and likely to increase becoming 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph on 11 th June, 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph during 12 th and 50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph during 13 th to 15 th June.</p> | |

High wave warning from INCOIS:

Maharashtra: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.7 meters are predicted during 17:30 hours on 10-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 11-06-2023 along the coast from Malvan to Vasai of Maharashtra coast.

Goa: High waves in the range of 3.5 - 3.8 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 10-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 11-06- 2023 along the coast of Goa between Vengurla to Vasco.

Gujarat High waves in the range of 3.5 - 6.5 meters are forecasted during 17:30 hours on 10-06-2023 to 23:30 hours of 11-06-2023 along the coast from Jakhau to Diu Head of Gujarat coast.

Port Warning for Maharashtra-Goa coast :-

The very severe cyclonic storm "Biparjoy" (pronounced as "Biporjoy") over eastcentral Arabian Sea moved nearly northwards with a speed of 6 kmph during past 6-hours and lay centered at 1730 hours IST of today, the 10th June, 2023 over the same region near latitude 17.1°N and longitude 67.3°E, about 620 km west-southwest of Mumbai, 560 km south-southwest of Porbandar, 620 km south-southwest of Dwarka, 700 km south of Naliya and 870 km south of Karachi.

It is likely to intensify further into an extremely severe cyclonic storm during next 12 hours. It is very likely to move nearly northwards and reach near Pakistan coast around evening of 15 th June, 2023.
