Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along & off South Maharashtra - Goa coasts on 16th Sept 2025 to 17th Sept 2025.

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over some parts of northwest, adjoining & some parts of westcentral Arabian Sea and along & off Oman coast; over Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.
Day 2 (17-Sep-2025):	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of southwest & westcentral Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia, south Oman & adjoining Yemen coasts. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.
Day 3 (18-Sep-2025):	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of southwest & few parts of westcentral Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off north Oman coast & adjoining sea area, over Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.
Day 4 (19-Sep-2025):	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of southwest & few parts of westcentral Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off north Oman coas & adjoining sea area, over Gulf of Mannar & adjoining Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.
Day 5 (20-Sep-2025):	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail over some parts of southwest & few parts of westcentral Arabian Sea, along and off Somalia coast. 
