Synoptic Situation:- Due to steep pressure gradient strong winds along and off Gujarat coast very likely to prevail.

1. Fishermen warning for North Gujarat coast (Jakhau, Mandvi (Kutch), Mundra, New Kandla, Navlakhi, Salaya, Okha, Bedi, Sikka(Jamnagar), Porbandar)

DAY 1- Strong wind with speed 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph is likely to prevail from South Westerly to Westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast. Sea will be rough with waves from South Westerly to Westerly direction along and off North Gujarat coast.

DAY 1- Strong wind with speed 30-40 kmph gusting to 50 kmph is likely to prevail from South Westerly to Westerly direction along and off South Gujarat coast. Sea will be rough with waves from South Westerly to Westerly direction along and off South Gujarat coast.

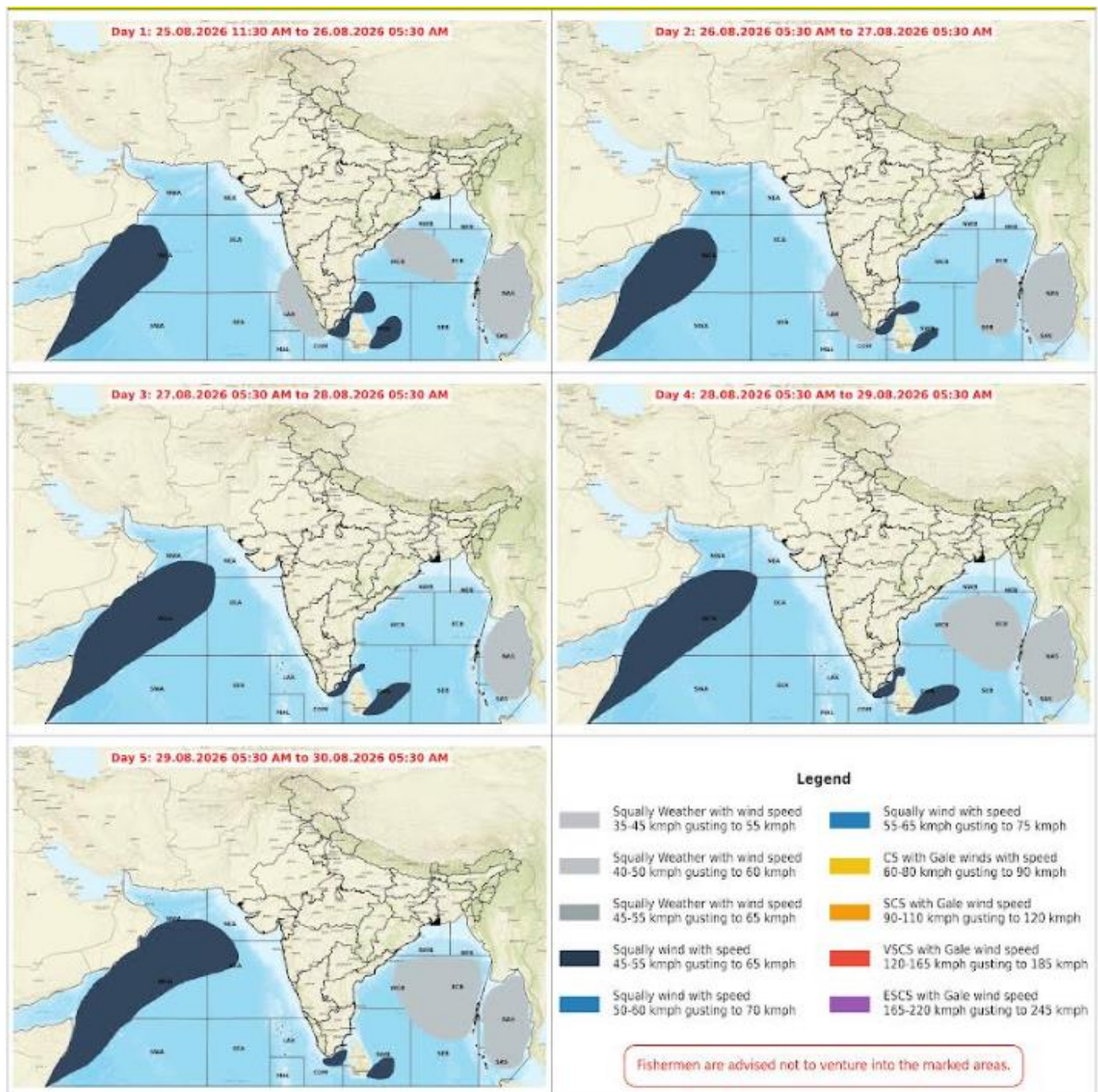
