FISHERMEN WARNING FOR GUJARAT COAST
(For 5 days from 01st November 2025 to 05th November 2025)

Subject: A well marked low pressure area over Eastcentral Arabian Sea Adjoining Northeast Arabian Sea.

Synoptic Situation: The well marked low pressure area over Eastcentral & Adjoining Northeast Arabian Sea with the associated cyclonic circulation extending upto 5.8 km above mean sea level persisted over the same region at 1430 hrs IST of today, the 1st November 2025. It is likely to continue to move east-northeastwards towards South Gujarat and adjoining North Maharashtra coasts across northeast Arabian Sea and weaken into a Low-Pressure Area during next 24 hours.

SIGNAL:-KEEP HOISTED THE SIGNAL LC-III FOR ALL THE PORTS OF NORTH GUJARAT COAST AND SOUTH GUJARAT COAST NAMELY JAKHAU, MANDVI (KUTCH), MUNDRA, NEW KANDLA, SIKKA NAVLAKHI, JAMNAGAR, SALAYA, PORBANDAR, OKHA, VERAVAL, MULDWARKA, DIU, JAFRABAD, PIPAVAV, VICTOR, BHAVNAGAR, ALANG, BHARUCH, DAHEJ, MAGDALLA AND DAMAN.

Warnings:

i) Rainfall Warning:

Gujarat region: Light to moderate rainfall at many places with heavy rainfall at isolated places is very likely on 1st November.

Saurashtra & Kutch: Light to moderate rainfall at most places with heavy rainfall at isolated places on 1st November.

ii) Wind Warnings:

Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over northeast Arabian Sea and along & off Gujarat coast on 01st November, becoming 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph till 2nd November.

iii) Sea condition:

Sea Condition is likely to be rough to very rough over Eastcentral and northeast Arabian Sea & along & off Gujarat coast on 1st November.

(iv) Fishermen warnings:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into Eastcentral & northeast Arabian Sea and along & off North Konkan and Gujarat coasts till 2nd November.

1) Fishermen warning for North Gujarat coast (Jakhu, Mandvi (Kutch), Mundra, New Kandla, Navlakhi, , Salaya, Okha,Bedi,Sikka(Jamnagar),Porbandar)

DAY 1-Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail from Easterly to Southeasterlydirection along and off North Gujarat coast. Sea will be very rough withwaves from Easterly to Southeasterlydirection along and offNorth Gujaratcoast.

DAY 2-Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off North Gujarat.

DAY 1-Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail from Southeasterly to Southerly direction along and off SouthGujarat coast. Sea will be very rough with waves from Southeasterly to Southerly direction along and off South Gujaratcoast.

DAY 2-Squally weather with wind speed 35 kmph to 45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph likely to prevail along and off South Gujarat.
