Warning for Fishermen West Bengal Coast for next 5 days commencing from 09/07/2025

FISHERMEN WARNING FOR WEST BENGAL COAST FOR NEXT FIVE DAYS: Fishermen warning for west bengal coast for next five days: Yesterday's low-pressure area over Gangetic West Bengal & Neighbourhood lay over Gangetic West Bengal adjoining Jharkhand at 0830 hrs IST of today, the 09th July 2025. Under the influence of the same, squally weather with surface wind speed reaching 35 – 45 kmph gusting up to 55 kmph very likely along and off West Bengal-Odisha coast, North Bay of Bengal during 09-07-2025. Sea condition likely to be rough to very rough. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the North bay, adjoining Central Bay of Bengal and along and off West Bengal-Odisha Coast for next 24 hours.
