Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail along and off Gujarat coasts, some parts of Northeast Arabian Sea, some parts of Eastcentral, few parts of Northwest Arabian Sea; over few parts of Comorin Area.
Day 4 (09-Sep-2025)	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia and Oman coasts, many parts of Westcentral Arabian Sea & some parts of southwest Arabian sea. Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely to prevail over few parts of Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.
Day 5 (10-Sep-2025)	Squally wind with speed reaching 45 kmph to 55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along and off Somalia and Oman coasts, some parts of Southwest & Westcentral Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into above mentioned area during these period.

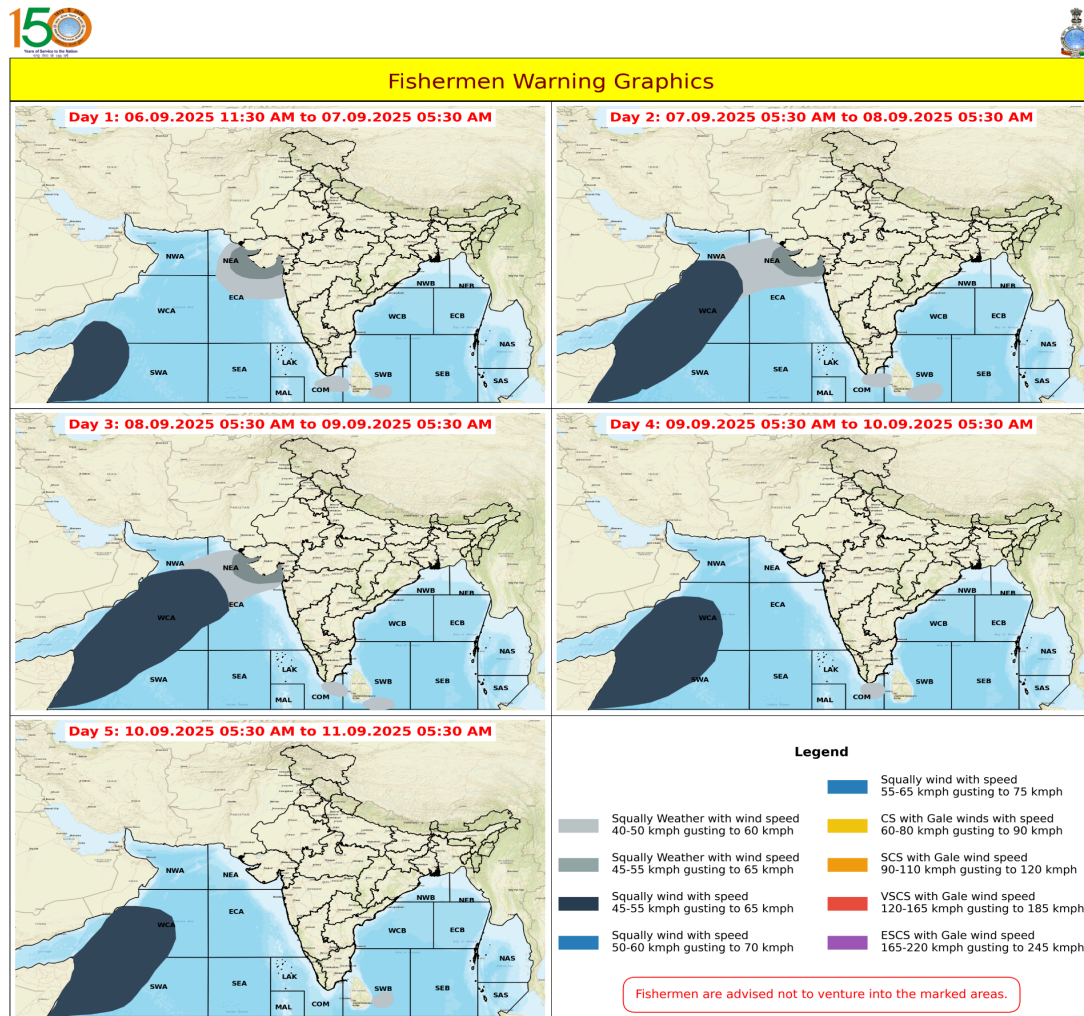
Port Warning for North Maharashtra coast :-

Keep Hoisted Local Cautionary Signal Number III (repeat L. C. III) at all ports of North Maharashtra coast From Dahanu to Shrivardhan.
