**WEATHER WARNING FOR FISHERMEN FOR  
KARNATAKA, KERALA COASTS AND LAKSHADWEEP AREA  
FOR NEXT 5 DAYS : 10<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 14<sup>th</sup> June 2023**

The very severe cyclonic storm "Biparjoy" (pronounced as "Biporjoy") over eastcentral Arabian Sea moved nearly northwards with a speed of 3 kmph during past 6-hours and lay centered at 1430 hours IST of today, the 10th June, 2023 over the same region near latitude 16.9°N and longitude 67.4°E, about 700 km west-northwest of Goa, 620 km west-southwest of Mumbai, 580 km south-southwest of Porbandar and 890 km south of Karachi.

It is very likely to intensify further into an extremely severe cyclonic storm during next 12 hours. It is likely to move north-northeastwards during next 24 hours and then gradually north-northwestwards during subsequent 3 days.

**WARNING FOR OTHER COASTS AND OPEN SEA FOR NEXT 5 DAYS**

ARABIAN SEA:	<b>10<sup>th</sup> June:</b> Gale wind speed reaching 135-145 kmph gusting to 160 kmph is prevailing over eastcentral & adjoining areas of westcentral Arabian Sea and likely to increase gradually becoming 150-160 kmph gusting to 175 kmph from night. Gale wind speed reaching 90-100 kmph gusting to 110 kmph is likely to prevail over adjoining areas of northeast Arabian Sea. Squally wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail along & off Gujarat coast. <b>11<sup>th</sup> June:</b> Gale wind speed reaching 155-165 kmph gusting to 180 kmph is likely to prevail over eastcentral and adjoining westcentral & northeast Arabian Sea and becoming 145-155 kmph gusting to 170 kmph over the region from evening. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along & off Gujarat coast. <b>12<sup>th</sup> June:</b> Gale wind speed reaching 140-150 kmph gusting to 165 kmph is likely to prevail over northeast and adjoining central Arabian Sea and becoming 135-145 kmph gusting to 160 kmph from evening. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along & off Gujarat coast. <b>13<sup>th</sup> June:</b> Gale wind speed reaching 135-145 kmph gusting to 160 kmph is likely to prevail over northeast and adjoining northwest & central Arabian Sea and decrease thereafter to become 125-135 kmph gusting to 150 kmph from evening. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along & off
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Gujarat coast.

**14<sup>th</sup> June:** Gale wind speed reaching 115-125 kmph gusting to 140 kmph is likely to prevail over northeast and adjoining northwest Arabian Sea and decrease thereafter to become 105-115 kmph gusting to 125 kmph from evening. Gale wind speed reaching 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph over adjoining areas of central Arabian Sea. Squally wind speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is likely to prevail along & off Gujarat coast.

**Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea area during the mentioned period.**

**BAY OF BENGAL:**

**10<sup>th</sup> June to 14<sup>th</sup> June:** Squally weather with wind speed reaching 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over Southwest Bay of Bengal, Southeast & adjoining Eastcentral-Westcentral Bay of Bengal, along & off Srilanka coast and Andaman sea.

**10<sup>th</sup> June to 14<sup>th</sup> June:** Squally wind with speed reaching 45-55 Kmph gusting to 65 Kmph is likely to prevail over Gulf of Mannar, South Tamilnadu coast and adjoining Comorin area.

**Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above sea area during the mentioned period.**

**HIGH WAVE WARNING:**

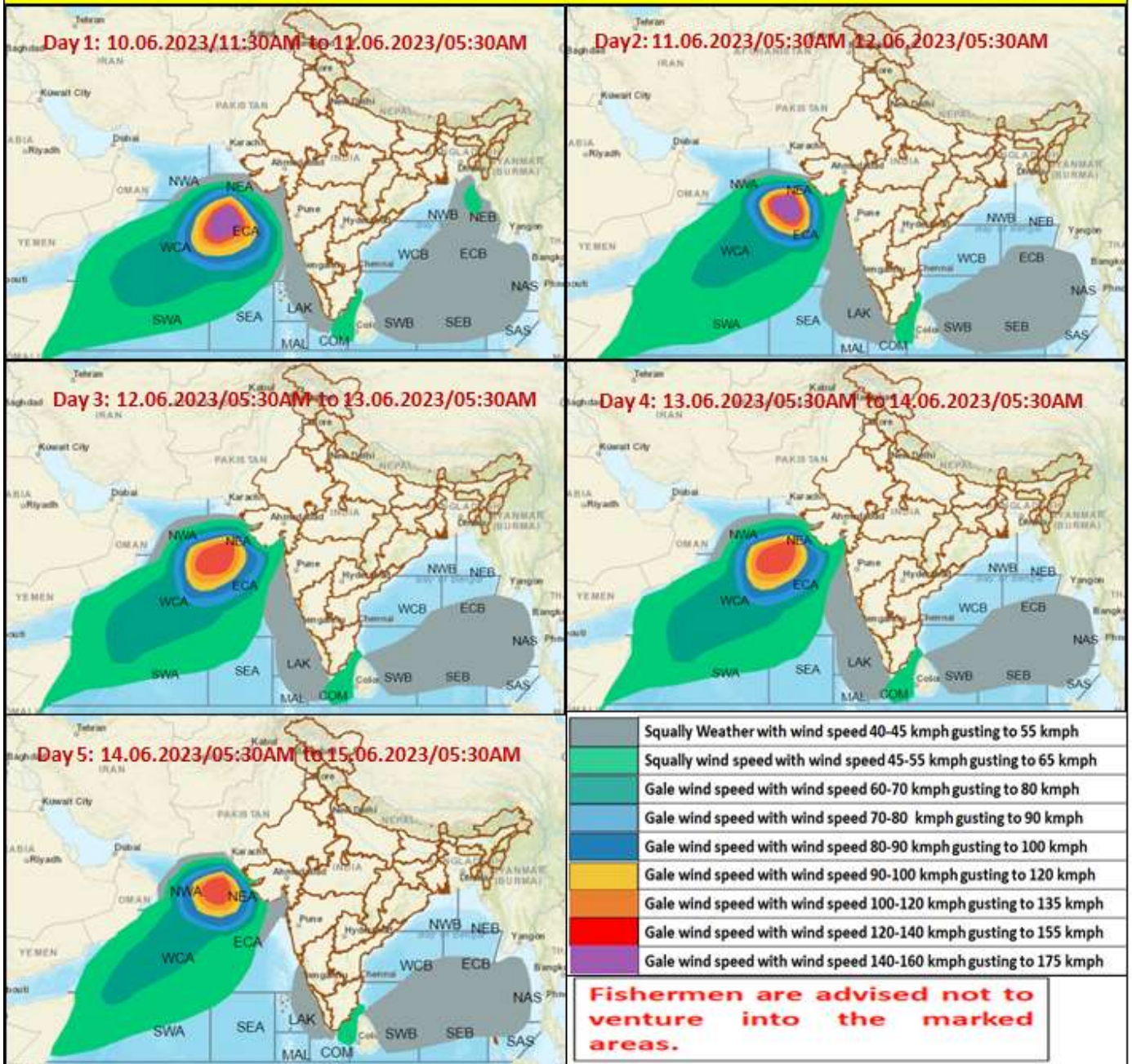
**Karnataka :** High waves in the range of 3.5 - 4.1 meters are predicted till 23:30 hours of 11-06-2023 along the coast from Mangalore to Karwar of Karnataka coast. Current speeds vary between 16 - 39 cm/sec.

**HIGH WAVE ALERT:**

**Kerala :** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.4 meters are forecasted till 23:30 hours of 11-06-2023 along the Kerala coast between Vizhinjam to Kasargod. Current speeds vary between 46 - 63 cm/sec.

**Lakshadweep:** High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.2 meters are till 23:30 hours of 10-06-2023 along Lakshadweep Islands between Minicoy to Bitra. Current speeds vary between 21 - 49 cm/sec.
