DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 25.08.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 25.08.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 25.08.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

The Low-Pressure Area over Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining areas of Jharkhand and north Odisha lay over Jharkhand & neighbourhood at 0300 UTC of today, the 25th August 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extended upto 5.8 km above mean sea level, tilting southwards with height.

The system is likely to move nearly west-northwestwards across Jharkhand during next 24 hours.

As per INSAT 3D(S), the Low Level Circulation (LLC) lay over Jharkhand & adjoining north Odisha and neighbourhood. Associated scattered to broken low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Gangetic West Bengal (Minimum cloud top temperature (CTT) is MINUS 40-70 °C) and isolated weak to moderate convection lay over Jharkhand and Bihar (Minimum CTT is MINUS 30-40 °C).

Scattered to broken, low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the westcentral & adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal, the Andaman Sea, the Gulf of Martaban and the Tenasserim coast. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over the rest Bay of Bengal and the Arakan coast.

ARABIAN SEA:

Scattered to broken, low to medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection lay over the southeast Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep Islands, the Maldives and the Comorin area. Scattered low to medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection over the central and southwest Arabian Sea.

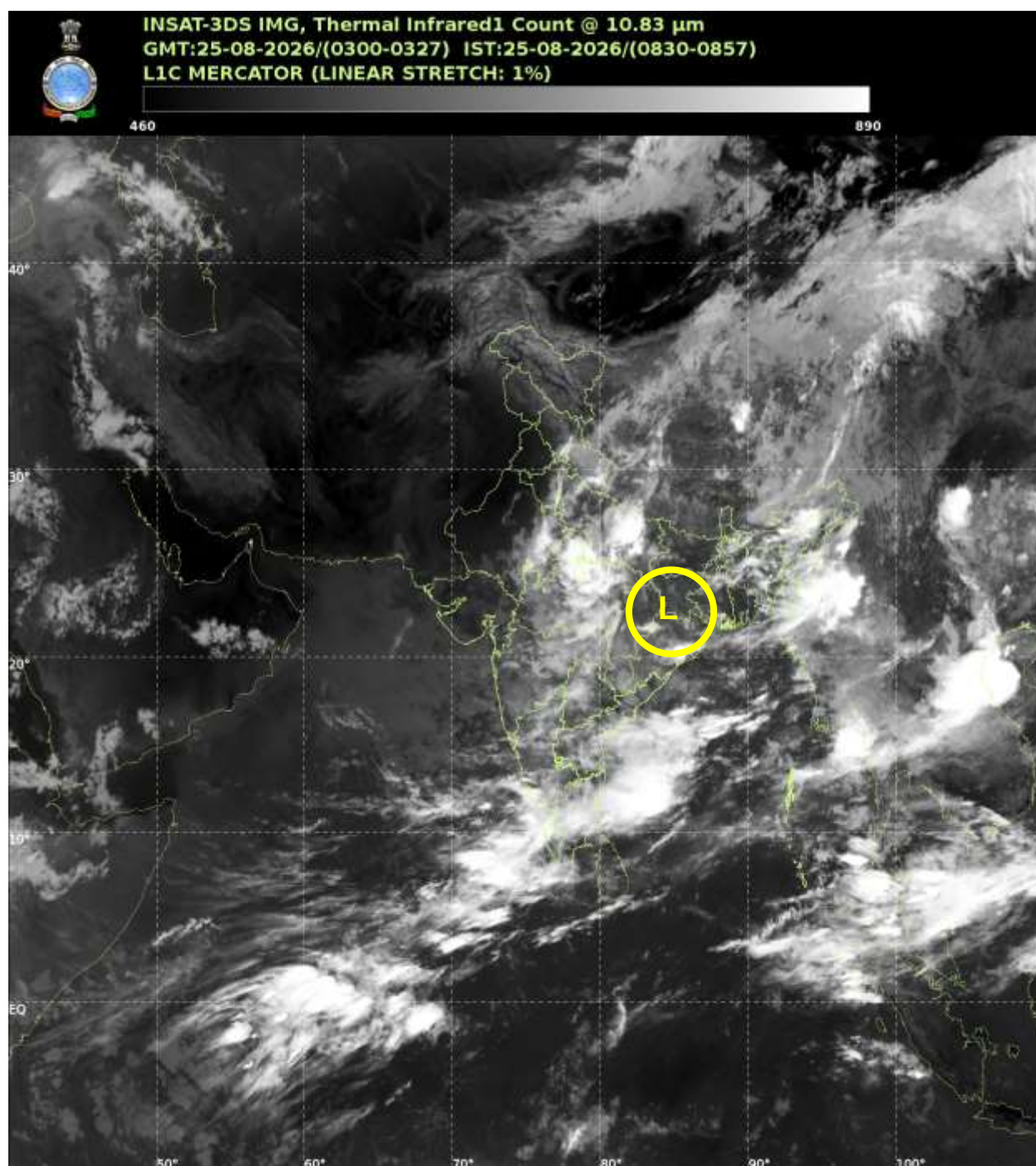
