DEMS-RSMC TROPICAL CYCLONES NEW DELHI DATED 13.09.2026

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR THE NORTH INDIAN OCEAN (THE BAY OF BENGAL AND THE ARABIAN SEA) VALID FOR THE NEXT 168 HOURS ISSUED AT 0600 UTC OF 13.09.2026 BASED ON 0300 UTC OF 13.09.2026.

BAY OF BENGAL:

Yesterday's Low Pressure Area over South Chhattisgarh & neighborhood now lay over southwest Madhya Pradesh and adjoining north Vidarbha at 0300 UTC of today, the 13th September, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height. It is likely to move west-northwestwards across southeast Rajasthan and adjoining north Gujarat during next 24 hours.

As per INSAT 3D(S), Clouds associated with Low Pressure area are Scattered to broken clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection over south Gujarat adjoining Gulf of Cambay (minimum cloud top temperature minus 70-90° C) and moderate to intense convection over rest of Gujarat south Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, north Interior Karnataka, Telangana (minimum cloud top temperature minus 40-70° C)

Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded moderate to intense convection lay over Bay of Bengal, Andaman Sea, Gulf of Martaban & Tenasserim coast.

ARABIAN SEA:

Yesterday's upper air cyclonic circulation lay over south Konkan adjoining Eastcentral Arabian sea between 3.1 & 7.6 km above mean sea level titling southwestwards with height persisted over the same region at 0300 UTC of today's, the 13th September, 2026.

Scattered to broken low and medium clouds with embedded intense to very intense convection over northeast & eastcentral Arabian Sea off south Gujarat - north Maharashtra coasts, Gulf of Cambay, southeast Arabian Sea, Maldives & Comorin area. Scattered low and medium clouds with embedded isolated weak to moderate convection over rest of Arabian Sea, Gulf of Kutch & Lakshadweep Islands area.

Cloud distribution: (a) Isolated: <25%, Scattered:25-50%, Broken: 51-75%, Solid:>75%, Convection Intensity: (a) Weak: Cloud Top Temperature(CTT)>-25°C, (b) Moderate: CTT:-25°Cto-40°C, (c) Intense: CTT: -41°Cto -70°C and (d) Very Intense::Less than -70°C Probability of cyclogenesis (formation of depression) :NIL:0%, LOW:1-33%, MODERATE:34-66% and HIGH:67-100%

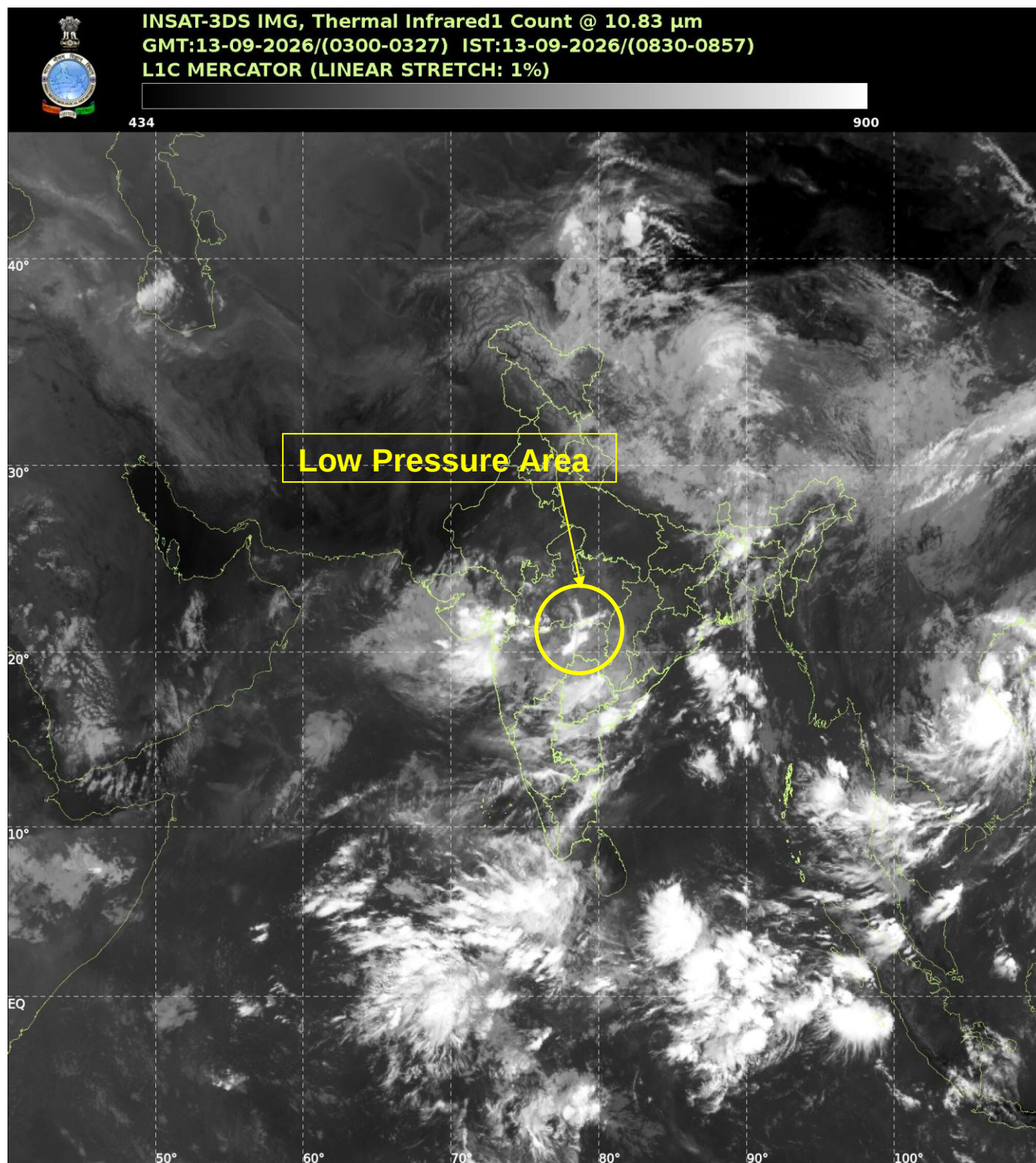
