HOURLY UPDATE ON CYCLONIC STORM “FENGAL”

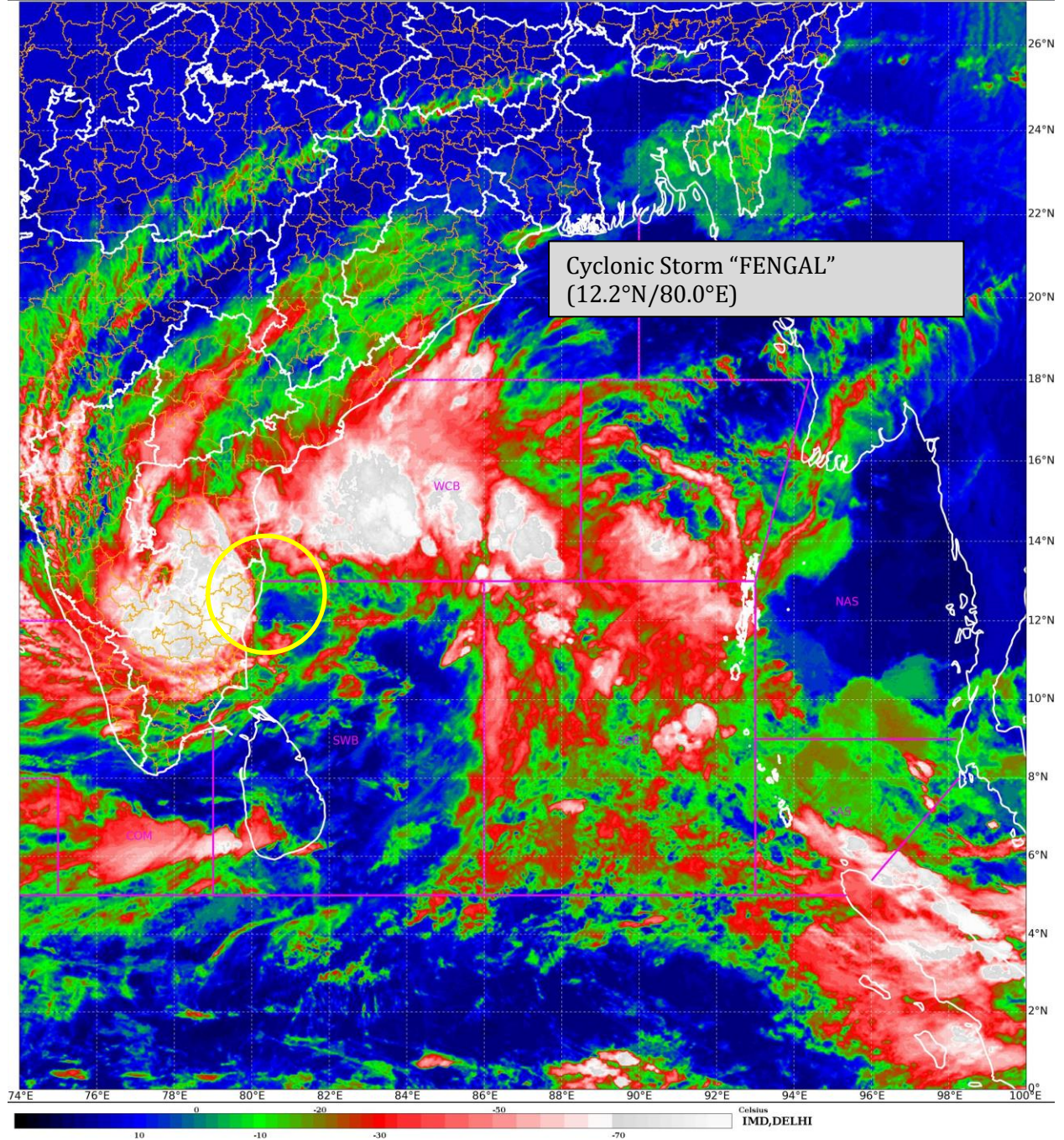
TIME OF ISSUE 2230 HRS IST

DATE/TIME (IST) OF OBSERVATION	BASED ON 30-11-2024 (2130 HRS IST)
LOCATION LATITUDE/LONGITUDE	The Cyclonic Storm “FENGAL” [pronounced as FEINJAL] over Southwest Bay of Bengal moved west-southwestwards with a speed of 10 kmph during past 6 hours and lay centred at 2130 hours IST of today, the 30th November 2024 over the southwest Bay of Bengal close to North Tamil Nadu - Puducherry coasts near latitude 12.2°N and longitude 80.0°E, close to the coast, 50 km south-southwest of Mahabalipuram, 30 km northeast of Puducherry and 90 km south-southwest of Chennai.
CURRENT INTENSITY WIND SPEED	Cyclonic Storm 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph
FORECAST	<p>Latest observations indicate that the forward sector of spiral bands associated with the cyclone has entered further inside the land. It is likely to move west-southwestwards and cross north Tamil Nadu-Puducherry coasts between Karaikal and Mahabalipuram close to Puducherry as a cyclonic storm with a wind speed of 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph during next 2 hours. Landfall process will continue during the same period.</p> <p>The system is being continuously monitored by the Doppler Weather Radar at Chennai.</p>
