## **COASTAL AREA BULLETIN**

DATE- 27.10.2025 TIME OF ISSUE- 0230 IST

EXTRA COASTAL WEATHER BULLETIN VALIDITY:- 2100 UTC OF 26-10-2025 TO 0900UTC OF 27-10-2025

**SYNOPTIC SYSTEM:** The deep depression over southeast Bay of Bengal & adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal moved west-northwestwards with a speed of 13 kmph during past 6 hours, intensified into a **cyclonic storm** "**Montha**" [Pronounced as Mon-Tha]" and lay centered at 2330 hrs IST of yesterday, the 26th October 2025, over southwest & adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal, near latitude 11.6°N & longitude 85.9°E, about 640 km east-southeast of Chennai (Tamil Nadu), 710 km southeast of Kakinada (Andhra Pradesh), 740 km west of Port Blair (Andaman & Nicobar Islands), 740 km south-southeast of Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) and 860 km south of Gopalpur (Odisha).

It is likely to continue to move west-northwestwards over southwest & adjoining westcentral Bay of Bengal during next 12 hours. Thereafter, it is likely to move northwestwards, then north-northwestwards and intensify into a severe cyclonic storm by morning of 28th October. Continuing to move further north-northwestwards, it is very likely to cross Andhra Pradesh coast between Machilipatnam and Kalingapatnam around Kakinada during evening/night of 28th October as a severe cyclonic storm with a maximum sustained wind speed of 90-100 kmph gusting to 110 kmph.
