**DAILY TWO Bulletin Valid for 12 hrs from 22 UTC of 2025-06-26 to 10 UTC of 2025-06-27**

<b>Synoptic Situation</b>	THE NORTHERN LIMIT OF MONSOON CONTINUE TO PASS THROUGH 27.0°N/68.5°E, 27.0°N/70.0°E, JAISALMER, BIKANER, JHUNJHUNU, BHARATPUR, RAMPUR, SONIPAT, ANUP NAGAR AND 29.0°N/70.0°E. THE TROUGH FROM NORTHEAST ARABIAN SEA TO CYCLONIC CIRCULATION ASSOCIATED WITH THE LOWPRESSURE AREA OVER NORTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL AND ADJOINING COASTAL AREAS OF ODISHA AND WEST BENGAL ACROSS SOUTH GUJARAT, MADHYA PRADESH, CHHATTISGARH EXTENDING BETWEEN 1.5 & 7.6 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL PERSISTS. SOUTHWEST MONSOON STRONG OVER CENTRAL ARABIAN SEA , MODERATE OVER SOUTH AND NORTH ARABIAN SEA .
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**North Maharashtra coast**

<b>Wind</b>	SOUTHWESTERLY TO WESTERLY 15 TO 20 GUSTING TO 25 KNOTS.
<b>Weather</b>	WIDESPREAD RAIN/THUNDERSHOWERS WITH ISOLATED SQUALL.
<b>Visibility</b>	MODERATE BECOMING POOR IN RAIN OR THUNDERSHOWERS AND VERY POOR IN SQUALL.
<b>Sea Condition</b>	ROUGH
