An upper air cyclonic circulation is likely to form over South Andaman Sea and adjoining areas around 21st November. It is likely to move westnorthwestwards and become a low pressure area over southeast Bay of Bengal around 23rd November. Thereafter, it is likely to continue move west-northwestwards and intensify into a depression over southwest Bay of Bengal during subsequent 2 days. WEATHER SEASONAL OVER ANDAMAN SEA .
