ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR COAST:

SYNOPTIC SYSTEM: THE NORTHERN LIMIT OF MONSOON CONTINUES TO PASS THROUGH 10°N/60°E, 9°/65°E, 8.5°N/70°E, 8°N/75°E, 7.8°N/78°E, 8°N/80°E, 10°N/80°E, 13°N/87°E, 16°N/90°E, 19°N/93°E AND 22°N/97°E.

CONDITIONS ARE FAVOURABLE FOR FURTHER ADVANCE OF SOUTHWEST MONSOON INTO SOME MORE PARTS OF SOUTHWEST AND REMAINING PARTS OF SOUTHEAST BAY OF BENGAL AROUND 4TH JUNE .

SOUTHWEST MONSOON MODERATE OVER ANDAMAN SEA.

Wind	MAINLY WESTERLY 15 - 20 KTS GUSTING 25 KTS OVER NORTH ANDAMAN SEA. MAINLY WESTERLY 15 - 20 KTS GUSTING 30 KTS OVER SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA.
Weather	RAIN OR THUNDERSHOWER VERY LIKELY TO OCCUR AT MOST PLACES OVER ANDAMAN & NICOBAR COAST.
Visibility	MODERATE BECOMING POOR IN RAIN/THUNDERSHOWER OVER NORTH ANDAMAN SEA. MODERATE BECOMING POOR IN HEAVY RAIN/THUNDERSHOWER OVER SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA.
Sea Condition	SLIGHT TO MODERATE OCCASIONALLY ROUGH OVER NORTH ANDAMAN SEA. SLIGHT TO MODERATE OCCASIONALLY VERY ROUGH OVER SOUTH ANDAMAN SEA.

Swell surge alert	SWELL WAVES IN THE RANGE OF 17.0 - 18.0 SEC PERIOD WITH 1.3 - 1.5 M HEIGHT ARE FORECASTED DURING 11:30 HOURS ON 03-06-2026 TO 20:30 HOURS ON 04-06-2026. IT ADVISED THAT THERE IS A POSSIBILITY OF SURGING OF WAVES, BOATS TO PLY WITH UTMOST VIGILANCE, RECREATION WITH DUE CARE
