AREA OF COVERAGE: AREA OF THE INDIAN OCEAN ENCLOSED BY LINES FROM THE INDO-PAKISTAN FRONTIER AT 23°45'N 68 DEG E TO 00 DEG N 6 DEG E, THENCE TO CAPE GARDAFUI; THE EAST AFRICAN COAST SOUTH TO THE EQUATOR, THENCE TO 95 DEG E, TO 6 DEG N, THENCE NORTH EASTWARDS TO MYANMAR/THAIL FRONTIER IN 10 DEG N 98 DEG 30'E NORTHWARDS COVERING ENTIRE BAY OF BENGAL.

VALID FROM 09 UTC OF 10TH MAY 2026 TO 00 UTC OF 12TH MAY 2026.

PART-II SYNOPTIC WEATHER SYSTEM AT 0300 UTC:

THE UPPER AIR CYCLONIC CIRCULATION OVER GULF OF MANNAR AND ADJOINING SRI LANKA EXTENDING UPTO 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL PERSISTS. UNDER ITS INFLUENCE A LOW PRESSURE AREA IS LIKELY TO FORM OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL DURING THE NEXT 48 HOURS.
