AREA OF COVERAGE: AREA OF THE INDIAN OCEAN ENCLOSED BY LINES FROM THE INDO-PAKISTAN FRONTIER AT 23°45'N 68 DEG E TO 00 DEG N 6 DEG E, THECE TO CAPE GARDAFUI; THE EAST AFRICAN COAST SOUTH TO THE EQUATOR, THENCE TO 95 DEG E, TO 6 DEG N, THENCE NORTH EASTWARDS TO MYANMAR/THAIL FRONTIER IN 10 DEG N 98 DEG 30'E NORTHWARDS COVERING ENTIRE BAY OF BENGAL.

SUBJECT: SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM "DANA" OVER CENTRAL & ADJOINING NORTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL (CYCLONE WARNING FOR ODISHA AND WEST BENGAL COASTS: RED MESSAGE)

THE SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM "DANA" (PRONOUNCED AS DANA) OVER CENTRAL & ADJOINING NORTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL MOVED NORTH-NORTHWESTWARDS WITH A SPEED OF 15 KMPH DURING PAST 6 HOURS, AND LAY CENTRED AT 21 UTC OF TODAY, THE 23TH OCTOBER, OVER THE SAME REGION, NEAR LATITUDE 18.3 DEG N AND LONGITUDE 88.3 DEG E, ABOUT 280 KM SOUTHEAST OF PARADIP (ODISHA), 310 KM SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF DHAMARA (ODISHA) AND 370 KM SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF SAGAR ISLAND (WEST BENGAL).

IT IS VERY LIKELY TO MOVE NORTHWESTWARDS AND CROSS NORTH ODISHA AND WEST BENGAL COASTS BETWEEN PURI AND SAGAR ISLAND CLOSE TO BHITARKANIKA AND DHAMARA (ODISHA) DURING MID-NIGHT OF 24TH TO MORNING OF 25TH OCTOBER, 2024 AS A SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM WITH A WIND SPEED OF 100-110 KMPH GUSTING 120 KMPH.




