HIGH SEA FORECAST FOR MET. AREA VIII (N)

AREA OF COVERAGE: AREA OF THE INDIAN OCEAN ENCLOSED BY LINES FROM THE INDO-PAKISTAN FRONTIER AT 23°45'N 68 DEG E TO 00 DEG N 6 DEG E, THENCE TO CAPE GARDAFUI; THE EAST AFRICAN COAST SOUTH TO THE EQUATOR, THENCE TO 95 DEG E, TO 6 DEG N, THENCE NORTH EASTWARDS TO MYANMAR/THAIL FRONTIER IN 10 DEG N 98 DEG 30'E NORTHWARDS COVERING ENTIRE BAY OF BENGAL.

VALID FROM 18 UTC OF 22ND FEB 2026 TO 12 UTC OF 24TH FEB 2026.

PART-II SYNOPTIC WEATHER SYSTEM AT 1200 UTC:

THE WELL MARKED LOW PRESSURE AREA OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL PERSISTED AT 1430 HRS IST OF TODAY, THE 22ND FEBRUARY, 2026. THE ASSOCIATED CYCLONIC CIRCULATION EXTENDED UPTO 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL. IT IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE TO MOVE WEST-NORTHWESTWARDS INITIALLY AND THEN GRADUALLY RECURVE NORTHEASTWARDS OVER SOUTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL DURING NEXT 48 HRS.
