<b>Synoptic Situation</b>	THE NORTHERN LIMIT OF MONSOON PASSES THROUGH 20°N/60°E, 20°N/65°E, 20°N/70°E, SURAT, INDORE, MANDLA, DALTONGANJ, MOTIHARI AND 28.3°N/83°E AS ON 24TH JUNE. THE TROUGH RUNS FROM THE ABOVE CYCLONIC CIRCULATION OVER CENTRAL PARTS OF MADHYA PRADESH TO EAST CENTRAL ARABIAN SEA NOW SEEN FROM SOUTHEAST PARTS OF MADHYA PRADESH TO EASTCENTRAL ARABIAN SEA ACROSS NORTH MAHARASHTRA AT 3.1 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL. THE TROUGH IN MIDDLE LEVEL WESTERLIES WITH ITS AXIS AT 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL FROM SOUTHEAST RAJASTHAN TO NORTH EAST ARABIAN SEA NOW RUNS FROM EAST CENTRAL ARABIAN SEA ACROSS GUJRAT AND NORTH MAHARASHTRA. THE TROUGH RUNS FROM THE ABOVE CYCLONIC CIRCULATION OVER CENTRAL PARTS OF MADHYA PRADESH TO EAST CENTRAL ARABIAN SEA NOW SEEN FROM SOUTHEAST PARTS OF MADHYA PRADESH TO EASTCENTRAL ARABIAN SEA ACROSS NORTH MAHARASHTRA AT 3.1 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL.
