

AURORA OBSERVATION :: Dated - Saturday 02/12/2023

Part One

TTT deep depression warning Bay of Bengal 020300 UTC.

Part Two

Yesterday's depression over Southwest Bay of Bengal further intensified into a deep depression and lay centered at 0830 hours IST oftoday, the 2nd December, 2023 over the same region near Latitude 10.6°N andLongitude 83.6°E, about 440 km east-southeast of Puducherry, 450 km east-southeastof Chennai, 580 km south-southeast of Nellore, 670 km south-southeast of Bapatlaand 670 km south-southeast of Machilipatnam. It is likely to move westnorthwestwards, intensify into a Cyclonic Storm over Southwest Bay of Bengal duringnext 24 hours. Thereafter, it would move northwestwards and reach westcentral Bayof Bengal off south Andhra Pradesh and adjoining north Tamil Nadu coasts by 4thDecember forenoon. Thereafter, it would move nearly northwards almost parallel and close to south Andhra Pradesh coasts and cross South Andhra Pradesh coastsbetween Nellore and Machilipatnam during forenoon of 5th December as a CyclonicStorm with a maximum sustained wind speed of 80-90 kmph gusting to 100 kmph. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and Andaman sea.
