Part Two

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of Southwest Bay of Bengal; most parts of Southeast Bay of Bengal; some parts of Eastcentral Bay of Bengal and entire Andaman Sea and Andaman & Nicobar Islands today, the 22nd May, 2021. The northern limit of Southwest Monsoon now passes through 5°N/80°E, 12°N/85°E, 13°N/90°E and 16°N/94.5°E. Under the influence of the cyclonic circulation over Southeast & adjoining Central Bay of Bengal, a Low Pressure Area has formed over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal. It is very likely to concentrate into a Depression over Eastcentral Bay of Bengal by tomorrow, the 23rd May morning. It is very likely to move north-northwestwards, intensify into a Cyclonic Storm by 24th May and further into a Very Severe Cyclonic Storm during subsequent 24 hours. It would continue to move north-northwestwards, intensify further and reach north Bay of Bengal near West Bengal and adjoining north Odisha & Bangladesh coasts around 26th May morning. It is very likely to cross West Bengal and adjoining north Odisha & Bangladesh coasts around evening of 26th May, 2021. Southwest monsoon been moderate to strong over some more parts of Southwest Bay of Bengal; most parts of Southeast Bay of Bengal and entire Andaman Sea; moderate over some parts of Eastcentral Bay of Bengal; Weather seasonal over North Bay, rest parts of Central Bay and rest parts of South Bay of Bengal.
