Yesterday's well marked low pressure area intensified into Depression and and lay centred at 0830 hours IST of today, the 02nd April, 2021 over North Andaman Sea and neighbourhood near latitude 11.0°N and longitude 96.3°E, about 400 km eastnortheast of Port Blair (Andaman Islands), 420 km northnorthwest of Phuket (Thailand) and 640 km south of Yangon (Myanmar). It is likely to move northeastwards towards Myanmar coast. It is likely to intensify into a deep depression during next 12 hours. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and South Andaman sea.
