Part Two

Southwest Monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of South Bay of Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Andaman Sea today on 22nd May, 2024. The Northern Limit of Monsoon continues to pass through 05°N/60°E, 06°N/70°E, 6.5°N/75°E, 7.5°N/80°E, 10°N/85°E, Mayabandar and 16°N/100°E. Conditions are favorable for advance of Southwest Monsoon over some more parts of south Bay of Bengal, remaining parts of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Andaman Sea and some parts of eastcentral Bay of Bengal during next 2 days. The Low Pressure Area over Southwest & adjoining Westcentral Bay of Bengal with the associated cyclonic circulation extending upto 7.6 km above mean sea level persists. It is very likely to move northeastwards and concentrate into a Depression over central parts of Bay of Bengal by morning of 24th May, 2024. It is likely to move northeastwards, intensify further and reach northeast & adjoining northwest Bay of Bengal by 25th evening. South west monsoon moderate to strong over some parts of south Bay of Bengal & Andaman sea. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and Andaman sea.
