Southwest monsoon has withdrawn from the entire country today, the 15th October 2024. Simultaneously, the Northeast Monsoon rainfall activity has commenced over the southeast peninsular India today, the 15th October, in association with following features. The well marked low pressure area over the central part of south Bay of Bengal persisted over the same region at 0830 hours IST of today, the 15th October 2024. It is likely to move west-northwestwards and intensify into a depression over southwest Bay of Bengal during next 24 hours. It is likely to continue to move west-northwestwards towards north Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and adjoining south Andhra Pradesh coasts during subsequent 24 hours.
