The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) now passes through lat. 10°N/ Long. 60°E, lat. 10°N/ Long. 70°E, Kochi, Palayamkottai, lat. 90°N/ Long. 80°E, 12°N/85°E, 14°N/90°E and 17°N/94°E. Southwest monsoon is likely to advance into some more parts of south and Central Bay of Bengal during next 2 days. Southwest Monsoon weak over South East Bay of Bengal and Andaman sea; weak to moderate over some parts of West Central Bay, most parts of South West Bay of Bengal and some parts of East Central Bay of Bengal. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal.
