Yesterday's Low Pressure area over Southeast Bay of Bengal & adjoining East Equatorial Indian Ocean now lies as Well Marked Low Pressure Area over the same region. It is very likely to move west-northwestwards, intensify further into a Depression around 30th January over southwest Bay of Bengal and reach near Sri Lanka coast around 01st February. Weather seasonal over rest Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea.
